

## *Shamrocks too slick for Oilers*

**MARLBORO** — Quarterback **Randy Schenauer** passed for three touchdowns to lead Marlboro past the Brockton Oilers 40-13, in an Eastern Football League game Friday night.

The loss drops the Oilers (2-7) from contention for post-season play and moves Marlboro (6-3) to within one game of clinching second place.

Schenauer found wide receiver **Steve Norman** in the end zone twice, once for 27 yards in the second period and for 5 yards in the third period.

Brockton scored its first touchdown on a **Steve Venckus** four yard touchdown pass from quarterback **Bob Hanlon** with 2:32 left in the second period to cut the Marlboro lead to 21-6 at halftime.

The final Oilers touchdown came in the fourth quarter when Hanlon connected with **Bruce Compton** for a 22-yard scoring strike. **Paul Blanchard** kicked the extra point for Brockton.
