

# Oilers bow, 18-15

ALBANY — The Randolph Oilers lost their fifth game against three victories yesterday, bowing to the Albany Metro Maulers, 18-15.

Trailing, 10-0, in the second quarter of the Eastern Football League game, the Oilers scored on a two-yard pass from quarterback Fred Beissner to Steve Roan. Roan was an "accidental" scorer; the pass was intended for Norm Eliason, but skipped off his hands to Roan.

In the fourth quarter, Randolph scored again on a one-yard sneak by Beissner. The touchdown was set up by Chip Howard's interception and return to the Albany 12. Ed Nelson rushed to the one and Beissner scored from there.

That put the Oilers ahead, 15-10, but they lost when Rich Burke of Albany ran the ball 37 yards for the winning touchdown.
