Teams interested in joining the Eastern Football League can obtain the necessary information by contacting League President Paul Bartlett (617-322-9091) or Ralph Grasso (617-485-3223), league public relations director.

The league meets monthly and teams interested in joining the EFL would be wise to attend a league meeting to find out the particulars. Teams joining the EFL must have a home field with lights for night games. League dues are currently set at \$500 per year. New franchises must pay new franchise fee \$1,000 and post a \$750 performance bond which remains in the league treasury with \$250 being returned to the team once it successfully completes one league season. The EFL holds its winter meetings on Cape Cod in January at which time prospective new teams are screened by the league's franchise committee.
