

Oilers post EFL win

METHUEN — Quarterback Bobby Witt completed seven of 10 passes for 132 yards and three touchdowns, pacing the visiting Randolph Oilers (1-1) to their first victory of the season, 34-0 over Methuen, in Eastern Football League action Saturday.

After kicking off to Methuen (0-2) to begin the game, the Oilers defense shut down the Outlaws, forcing a punt.

Randolph took over on its 44-yard line and, on the ensuing play, Bobby Witt hit brother Ricky Witt (three catches, two TDs) with a 56-yard scoring pass down the right sideline. Ray Almeida kicked the extra point.

Jay McGee capped a five-play, 37-yard drive with a six-yard touchdown run later in the first quarter, lifting Randolph to a 14-0 lead.

Mark Harding caught a 37-yard scoring pass in the second quarter.

Bobby Witt found brother Ricky again in the third quarter, capping an 80-yard scoring drive, and Terry Branch added the last Randolph score after a fumble recovery by Lester Pina.
