

## Oilers win after fast start

Despite a 17-0 lead at the end of the first half, the Randolph Oilers needed part of a 19-point fourth quarter to dispatch host Rhode Island, 36-14, Saturday and improve their record to 3-1 in the Eastern Football League.

Running back Mike Green (11 carries for 84 yards) scored his second touchdown of the game on an 18-yard scamper early in the fourth quarter for the Oilers.

Randolph tacked on insurance with a 2-yard Calvin Bryant score and a 37-yard TD jaunt by Anthony Comer.

Green led the Oilers in the first quarter, scoring on the game's initial drive with a 24-yard carry.

After a 37-yard field goal by Dave Canavan, Bryant (12 carries for 135 yards, three catches for 39 yards) put Randolph ahead, 17-0, on a 58-yard scoring run with 9:42 left in the half. Eric Boatwright, who attended Boston College, went 10-for-13 for 105 yards passing for Randolph.

The Oilers have a showdown with fellow third-place team Charlestown Friday night at Randolph High School.
