New franchises must pay a new franchise fee of \$3,000 and post a \$1,500 performance bond. After completing one successful season a partial refund of the performance bond will be returned to the franchise.

The league has grown bigger and stronger then founder Lee Chisem could ever had imagined. The Eastern Football League currently host eight teams from three states. The league plays a ten game regular season schedule that starts the in early July, Two wild card games and Two Semi-Finals games, leading up to the Eastern Football League Superbowl Finally. The caliber of players who compete in the Eastern Football League are bigger, stronger, faster and more skilled then ever before. More and more players entering the Eastern Football League possess college or professional experience. The league over the past five years have place several players in the professional ranks and many more players receiving try outs in the Pro's.

In 1993 the Eastern Football League produced its first MLFA National Championship team in the form of the EFL Marlboro Shamrocks. The Eastern Football League has not been with out its problems. The league has under gone several name changes since its birth in 1961. In 1973 the league adopted the name of the "Eastern Football League" then formulated league Bi-Laws and voted in league officers, lead by Maldan Attorney Paul Bartlett. Bartlett has been the leagues president along with league Commissioner George Murphy for over twenty two years of dedication. Other EFL officers include new Vice President Robert Brennan, Treasurer Peter O'Kane, Secretary Ralph Grasso, Acting Secretary Alfred Desper and public Relations Director Tony Sirrico. The league holds monthly meetings and appoints committees to address any league problems.

This foundation was to make the Eastern Football League the top amateur league in the Country, with the emphasis on good sportsmanship and pure amateur players, makes the Eastern Football League, The Best Game In Town.
