

Statistically, Oilers are making a mark

Although the Randolph Oilers are having a tough start this season in the Eastern Football League, a few of their players are among the league leaders statistically. Bob Witt of the Randolph Oilers has the top passing statistics in the EFL. Witt has completed 35 of 56 passes for 428 yards and five touchdowns. Former BC and Brockton High star Anthony Comer is third in rushing, running for 338 yards and three touchdowns in 44 carries, an average rush of 7.7 yards. Mike Lear is among the top pass catches with 13 receptions for 211 yards, a 16.2 average. Ben Butler leads the EFL in sacks with 3 1/2, and Dan Forman is among the top kickoff returners, taking seven back for 131 yards. . . .
