

HISTORY OF THE LEAGUE

League names: New England Football Conference, North Shore Football Conference, North Atlantic Football Conference, Eastern Pro Football Conference, EASTERN FOOTBALL LEAGUE....

Formed in 1961, the EFL will kick off its 36th Anniversary Season. It is the longest surviving amateur football league in the United States and has participated in Maine, New Hampshire, New York, New Jersey, Rhode Island and Massachusetts. The EFL has gone through five name changes, 65 towns, communities and cities, and gained three national titles – Marlboro Shamrocks, two consecutive national titles in 1993 and 1994, and the Mitchell Memorial Club of Middleboro in 1988 – both teams from Massachusetts. Marlboro has won the EFL title 11 times and the Mitchell Club, 5 times. Over 29 players have made the pros Including Butch Songin, Rod Choate and Stan Hiller, Patriots; Tom Dempsey, Philadelphia, and others.

There have been only 4 players who have rushed for 1000 yards. Some league records include 103 yard interception return, 99 yard fumble return, 102 yard kickoff return, 52 yard field goal, 48 pass attempts, most kicking points in a single season (92) and the longest continuous service to the EFL (36 years) by George E. Murphy, who has been Commissioner since the league's incention. Twelve

HOW TO JOIN THE E.F.L.

Teams interested in joining the Eastern Football League can obtain the necessary information by contacting George E. Murphy, Commissioner, at (617) 729-4840 Teams joining the EFL must have a home field with lights for night games.

Locker and shower facilities must also be available for both the home & visiting team. New franchises must pay a new franchise fee of \$1,500 and post a \$1,250 performance bond. After completing one successful season a partial refund of the performance bond will be returned to the franchise.

The EFL holds its winter/weekend meeting in January or February at which time prospective new teams will be accepted into the league based on the franchise committee screening report.
