



Oilers thump Maine Black Bears in Eastern League game

ORONO - Ryan Myers threw three touchdowns passes as the Randolph (Mass.) Oilers debuted in the Eastern Football League with a 27-0 victory over the University of Maine Football Club team Saturday night at Morse Field.

Charles Thomas added a second-quarter touchdown for Randolph on an 8-yard run. Also hitting paydirt for the Oilers were wr's Dan Carroll, Matt Trainor, and Anthony "TO" Kromah.

After establishing an early lead, the Oilers were able to dominate the time-of-possession battle thanks to a crushing running game led by powerful tackles Pete Hogan & T.D. Thompson, and guard/center Kevin Clark.
