The Farm Bill Wildlife Biologists on the Missouri team are partnership positions supported by the Natural Resources Conservation Service, the Missouri Dept. of Conservation, and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation. Dubinski will work with private landowners in Randolph, Macon, and Chariton counties helping them with wildlife and habitat management planning and securing funds to help implement those plans.

"His passion for our natural resources and experience will serve him well in this role in working with private landowners and his local communities."
