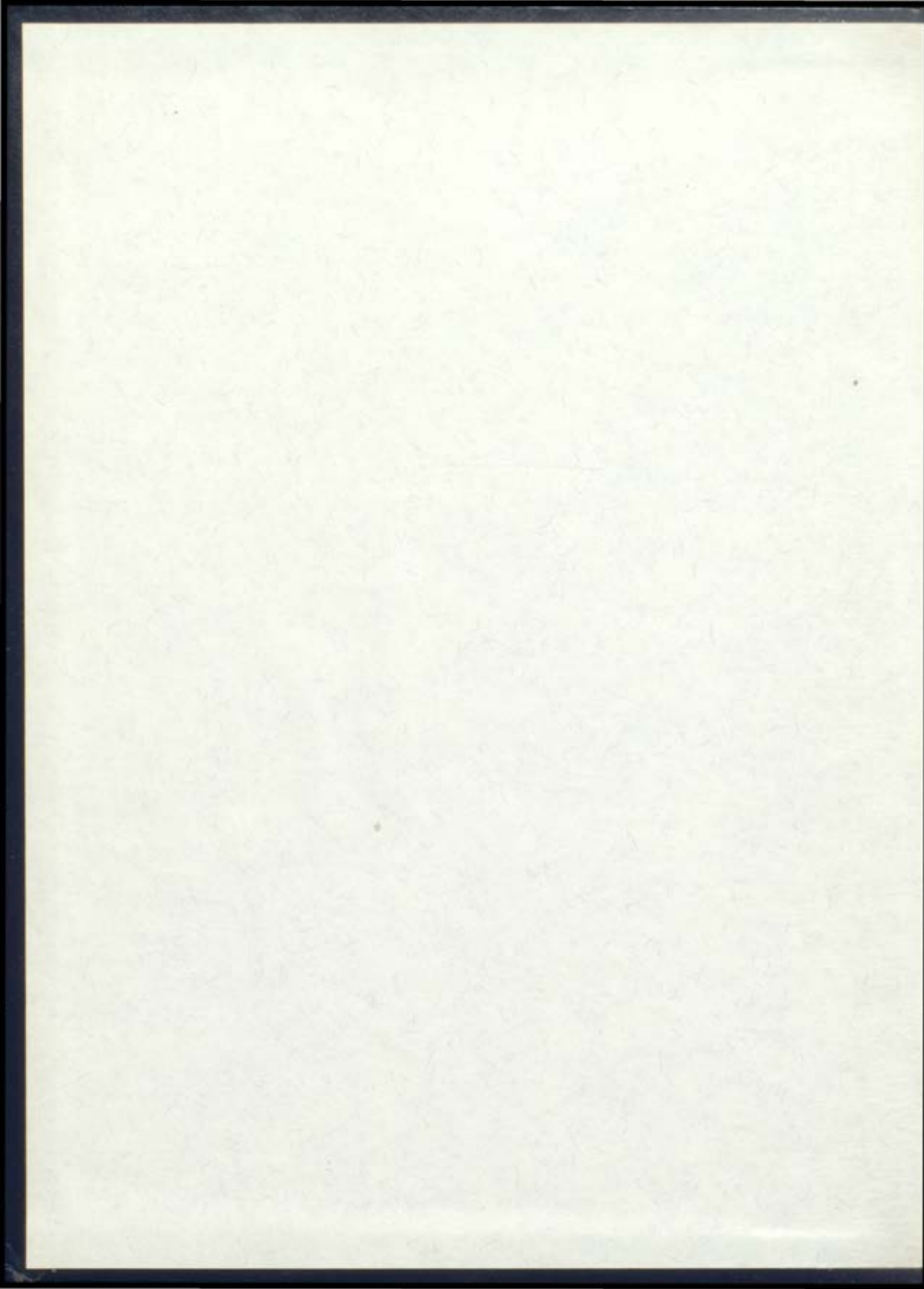
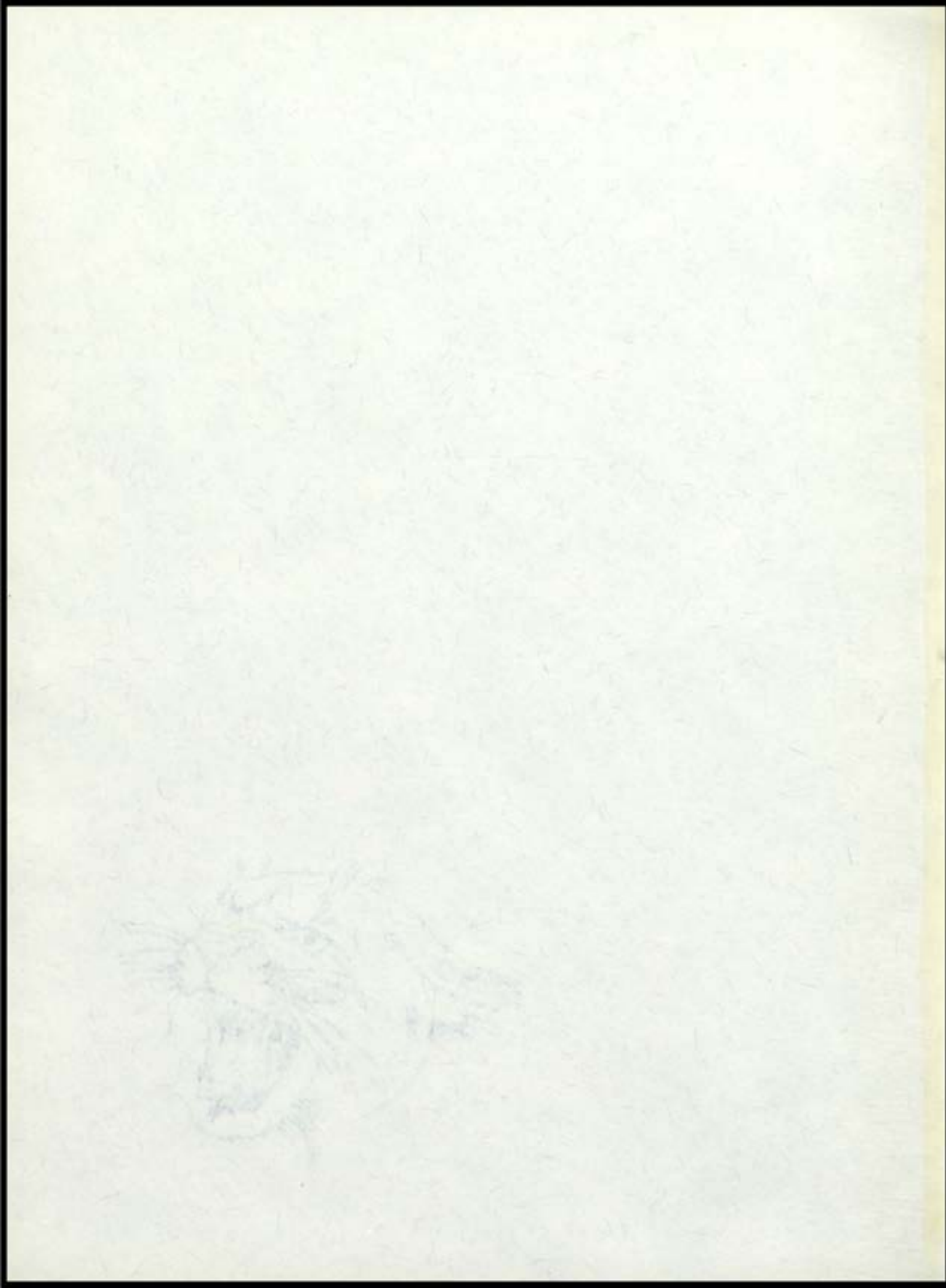

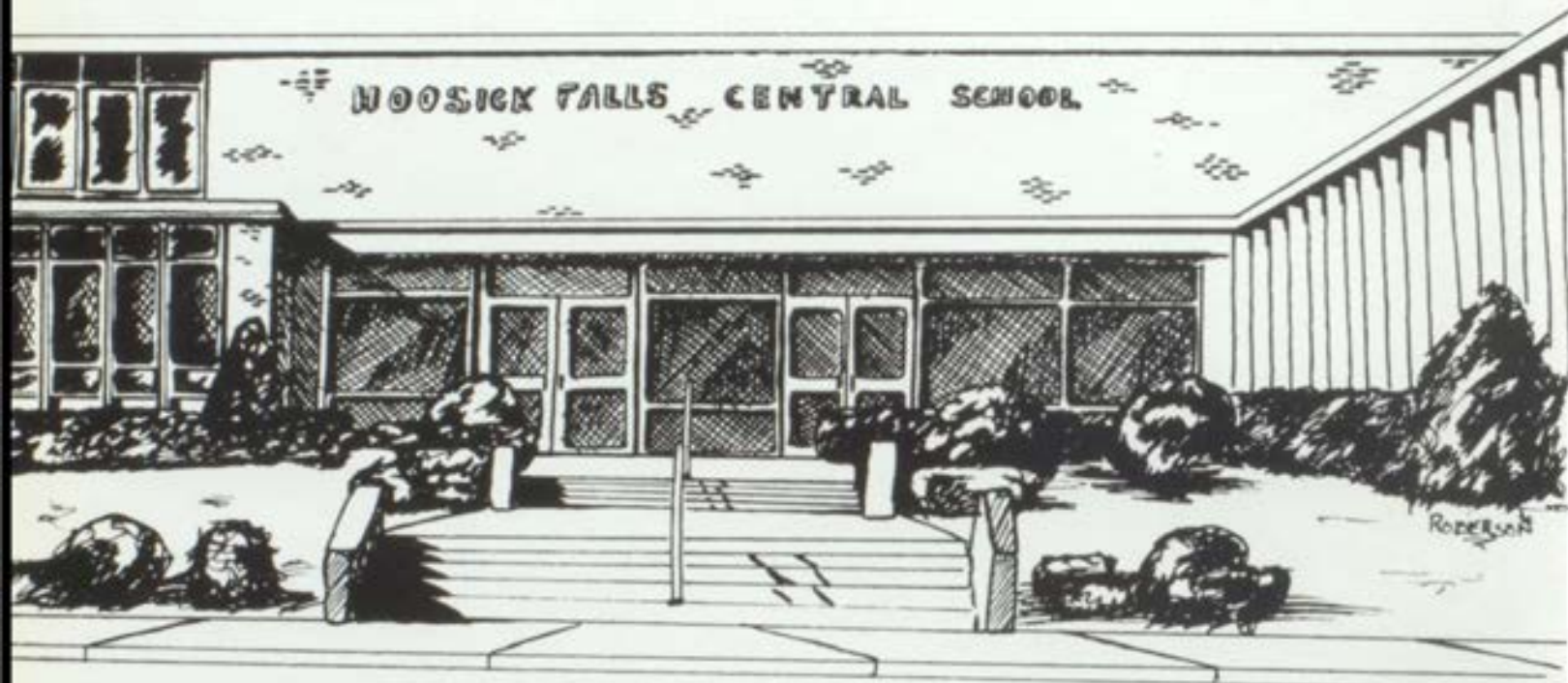
Looking back, we would like to say "Thank you" for all of the times that you were there for us.
