Honorable Mention goes to seniors Dan Vincent and Sean Keagan.

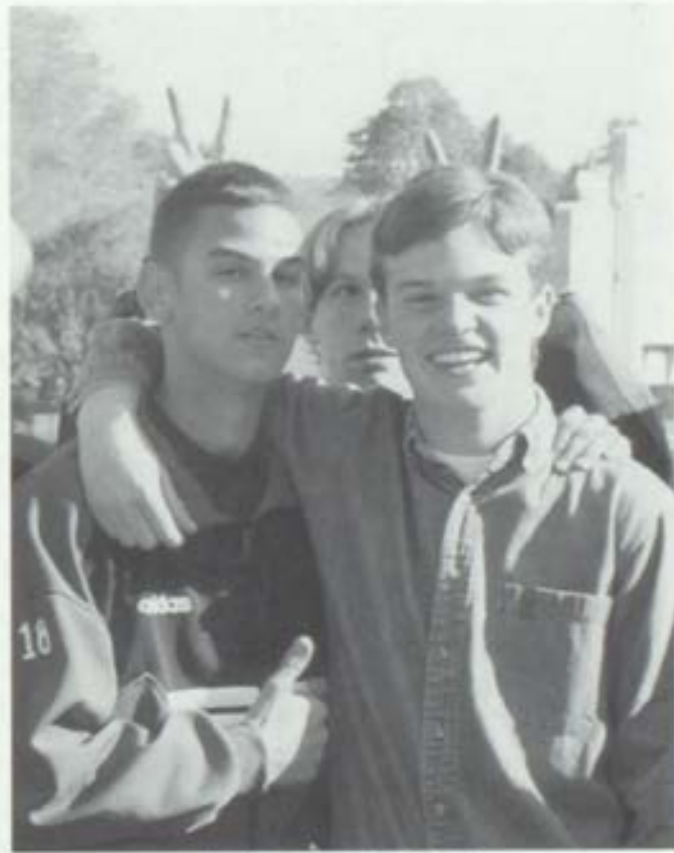
