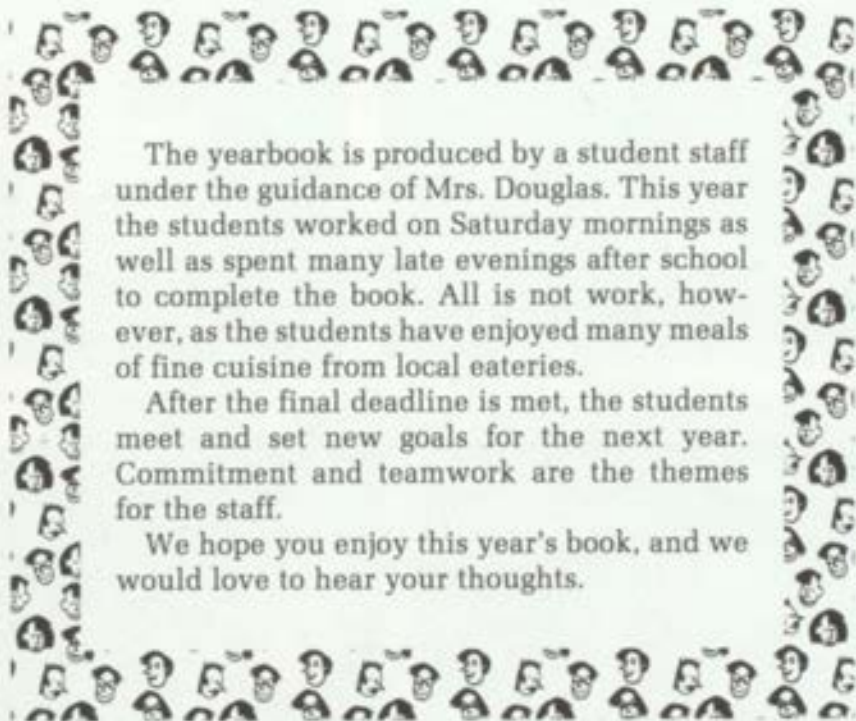
# BOOK

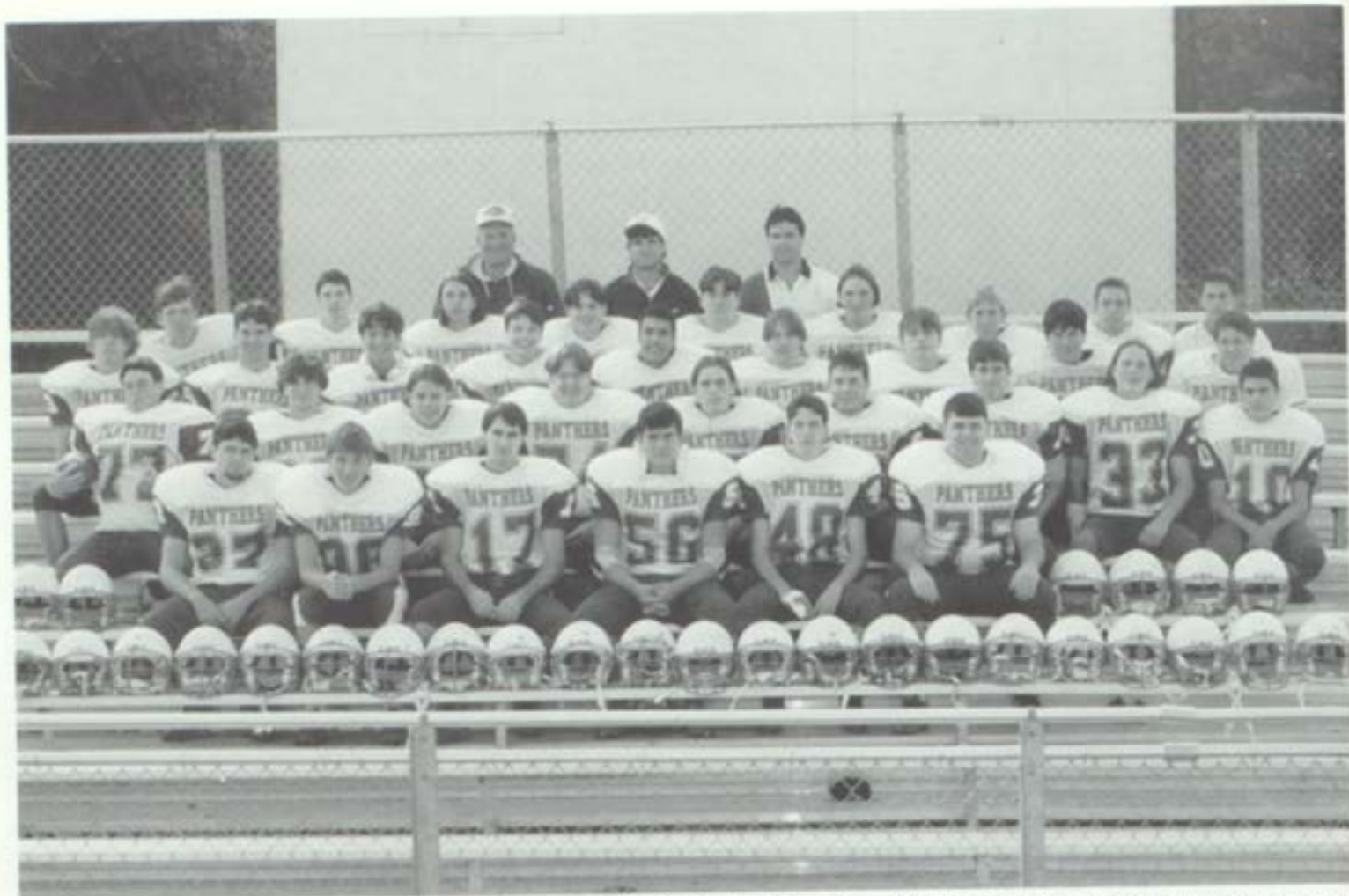

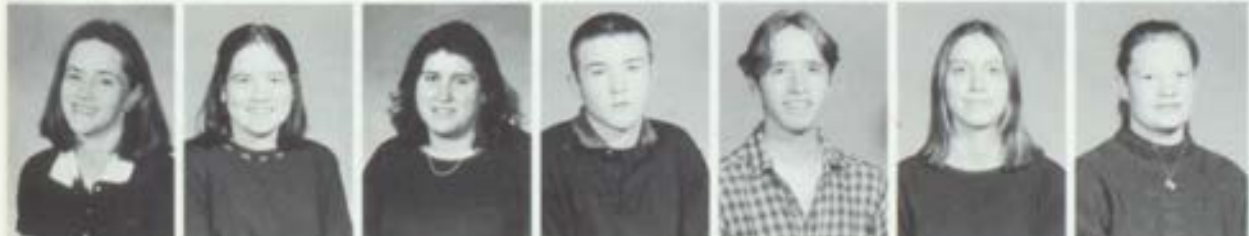

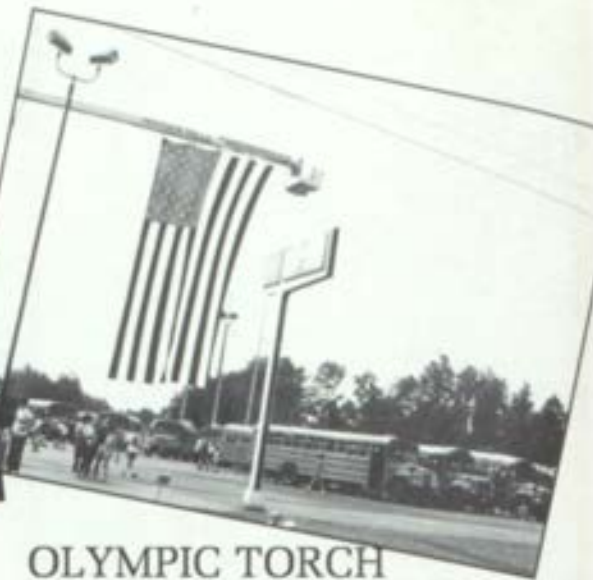
