





































FRESHMEN Class of 2003

The 1999/2000 school year saw a number of accomplishments and changes at Hoosick Falls High School.

School started a few days late in September so workers could put the finishing touches on the Middle School addition. The old "middle school corridor" became the math corridor (plus French!), but not tripping over sixth graders made it worth the wait.

Technology took center stage with two new business/computer labs, computers in the library and in every classroom. Courses were developed around the technology such as computer graphics and CAD and internet searches became an everyday occurrence. There were some terrific Powerpoint presentations and on-line testing in some classrooms.

A number of non-technology classes were added to the high school curriculum. These included photography, statistics, applied physics, sculpture and a new survival skills class. Physical education added a unit on cross-country skiing and snowshoeing.
