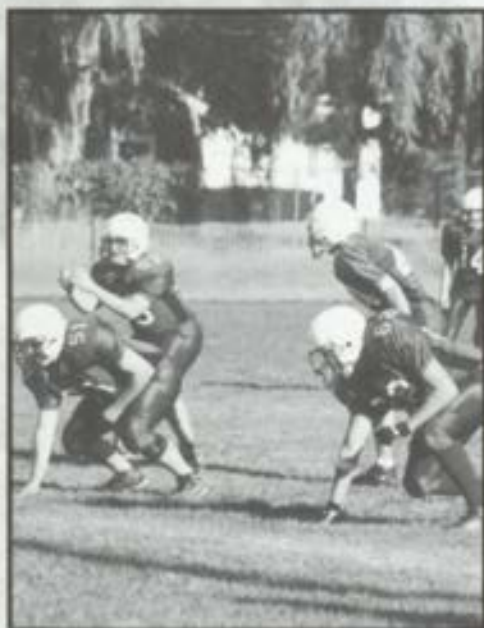
FOOTBALL GAINS SOME YARDAGE
