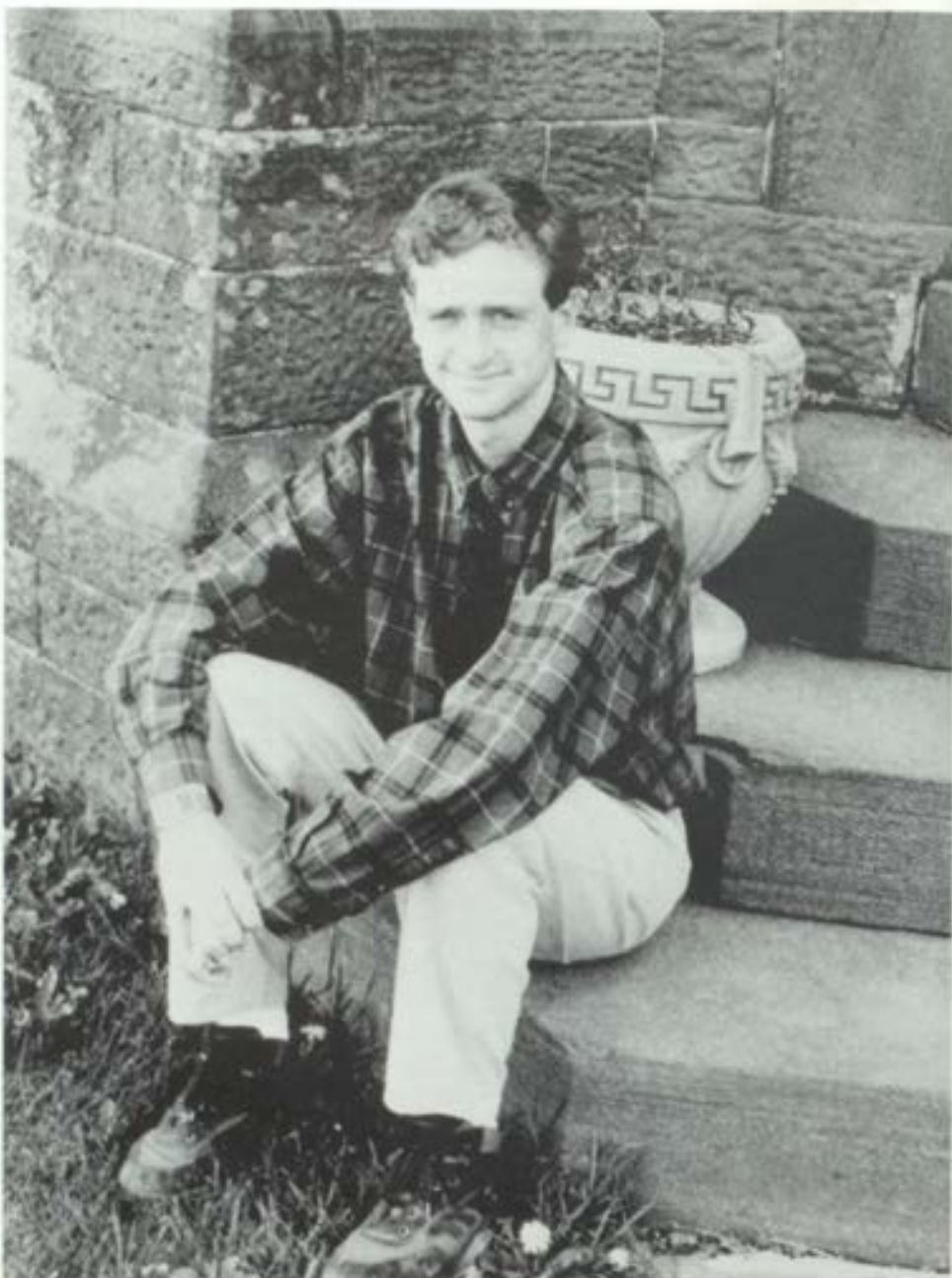
Father Clements: I'm really going to miss adviser meetings, we had a nice group.

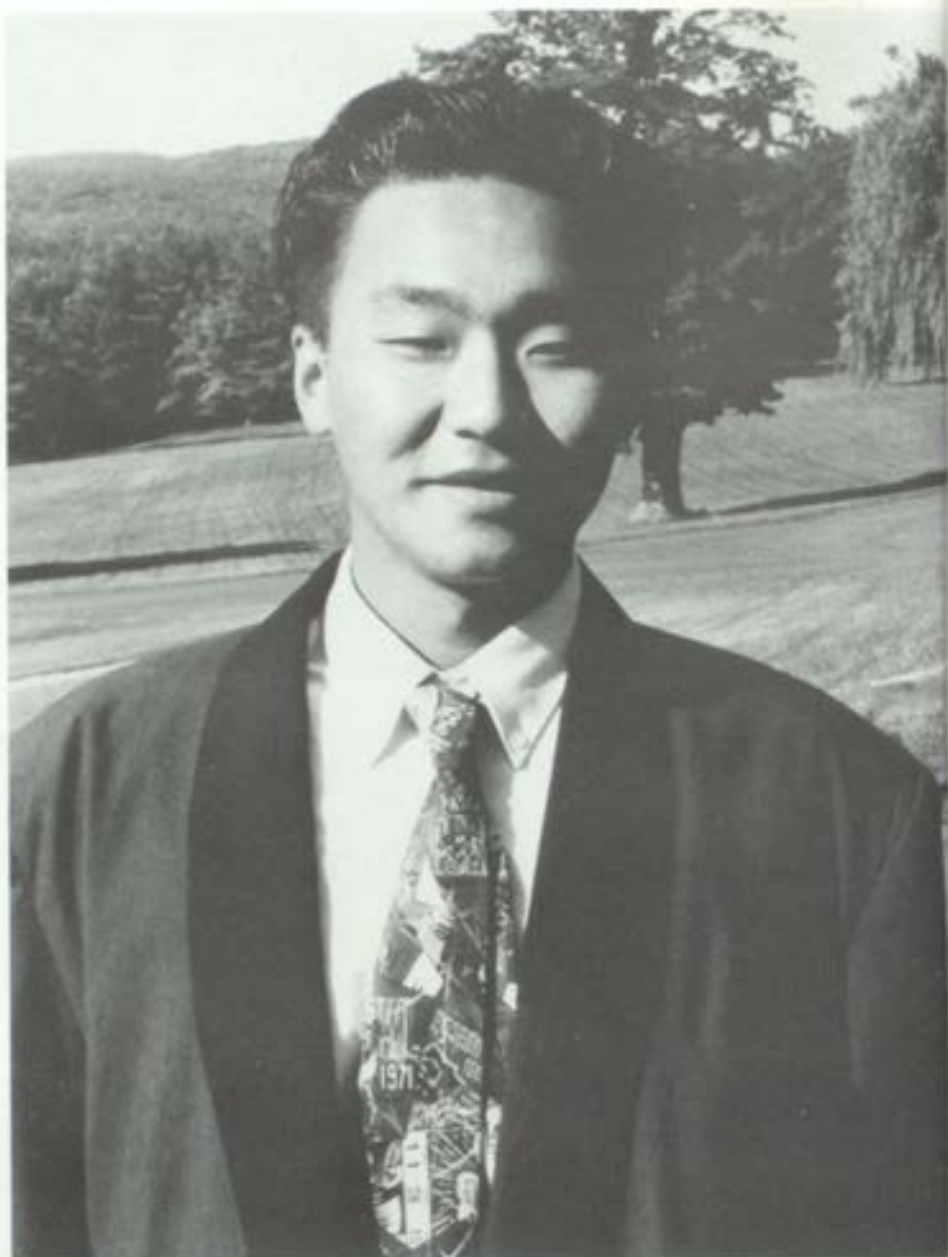

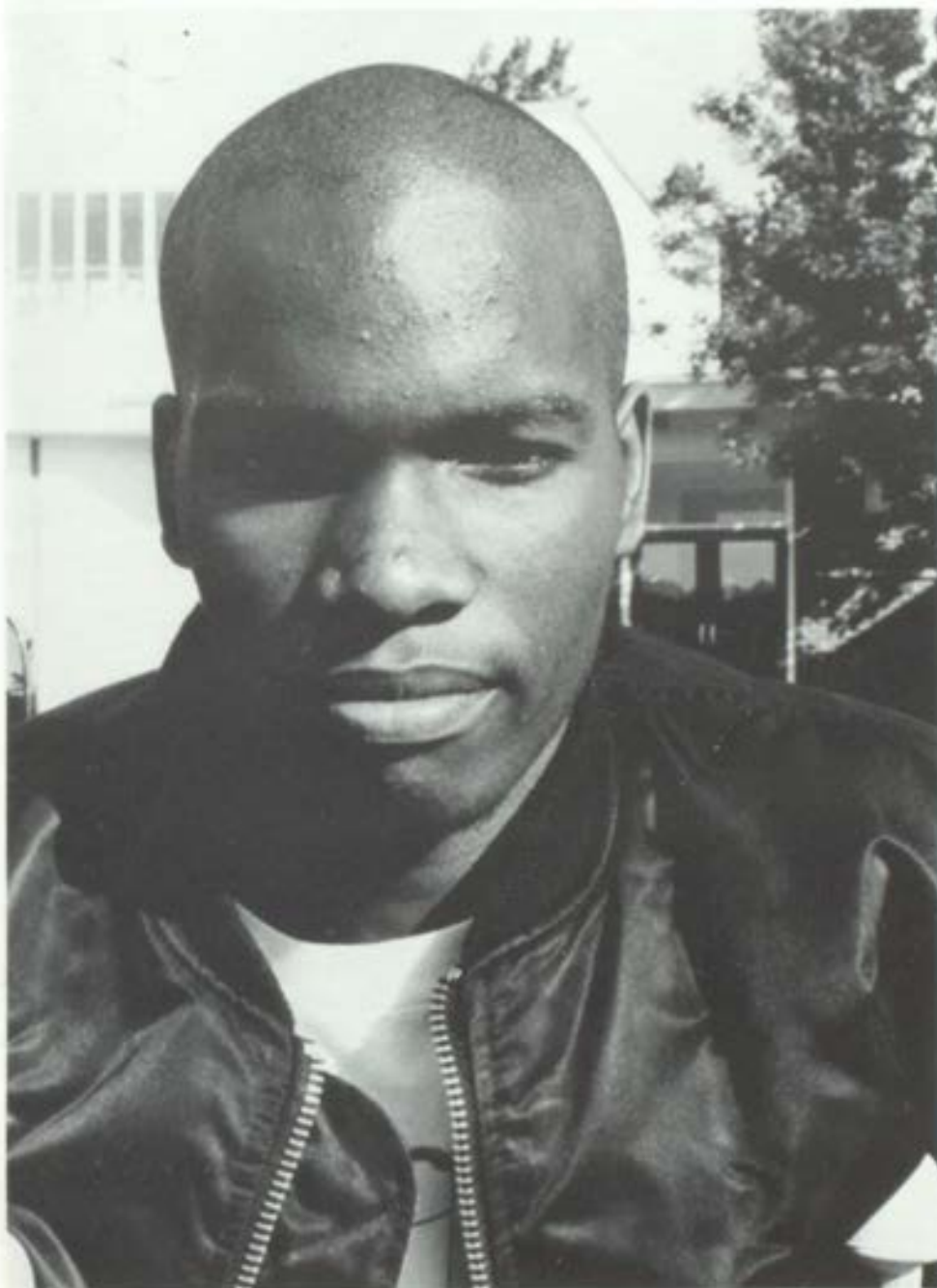

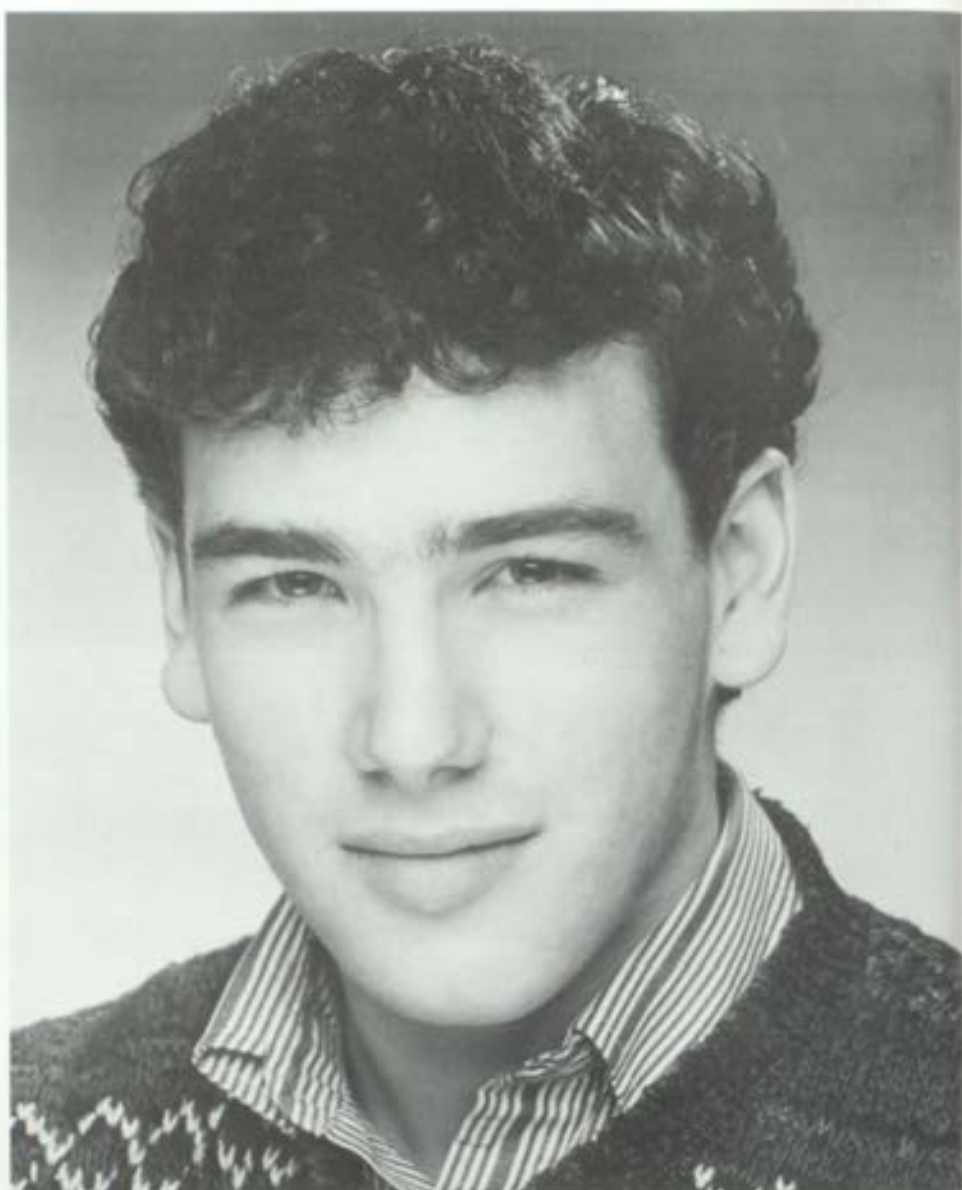
