Please keep in touch and come back to visit from time to time.

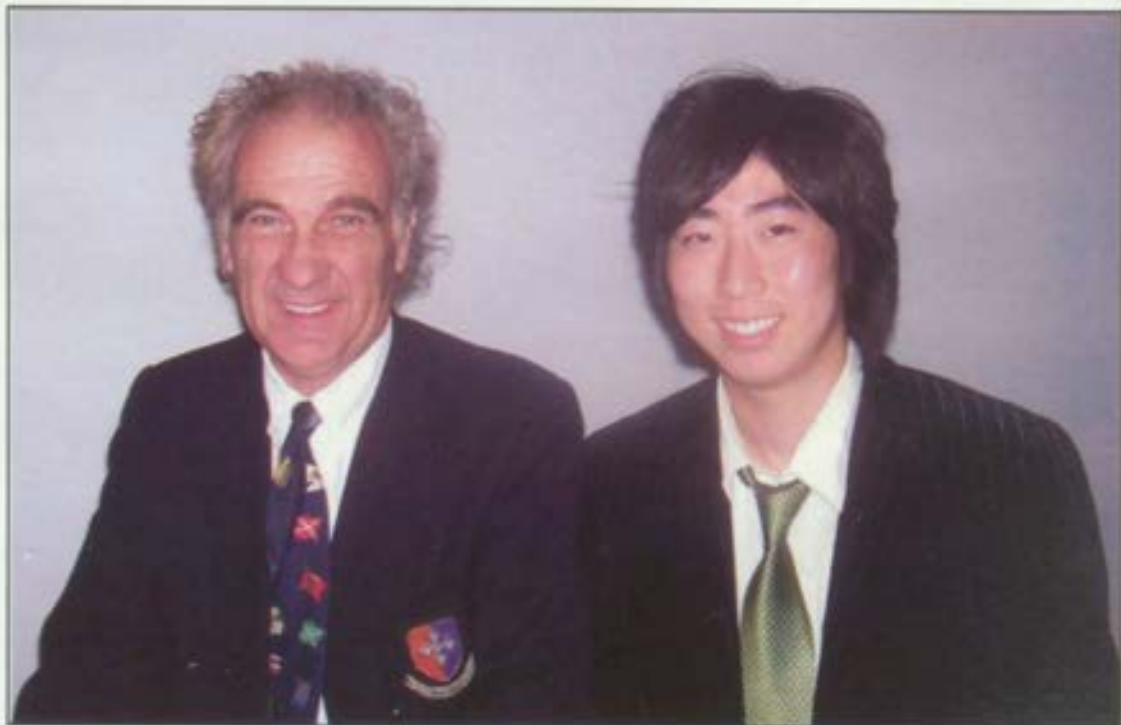

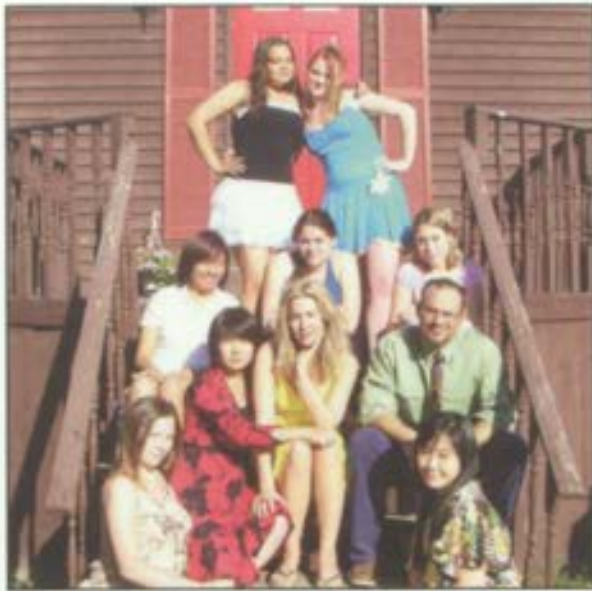

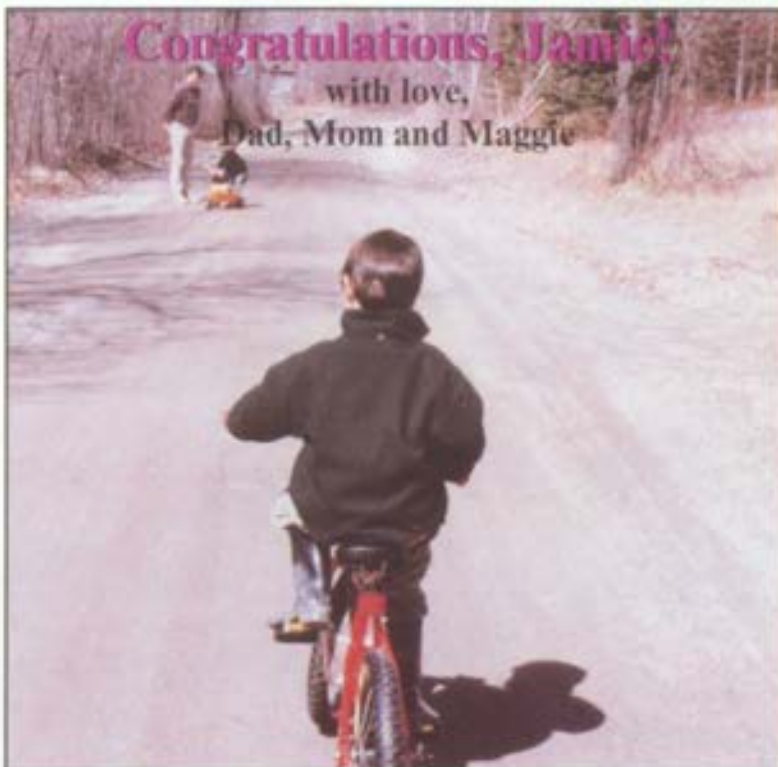
