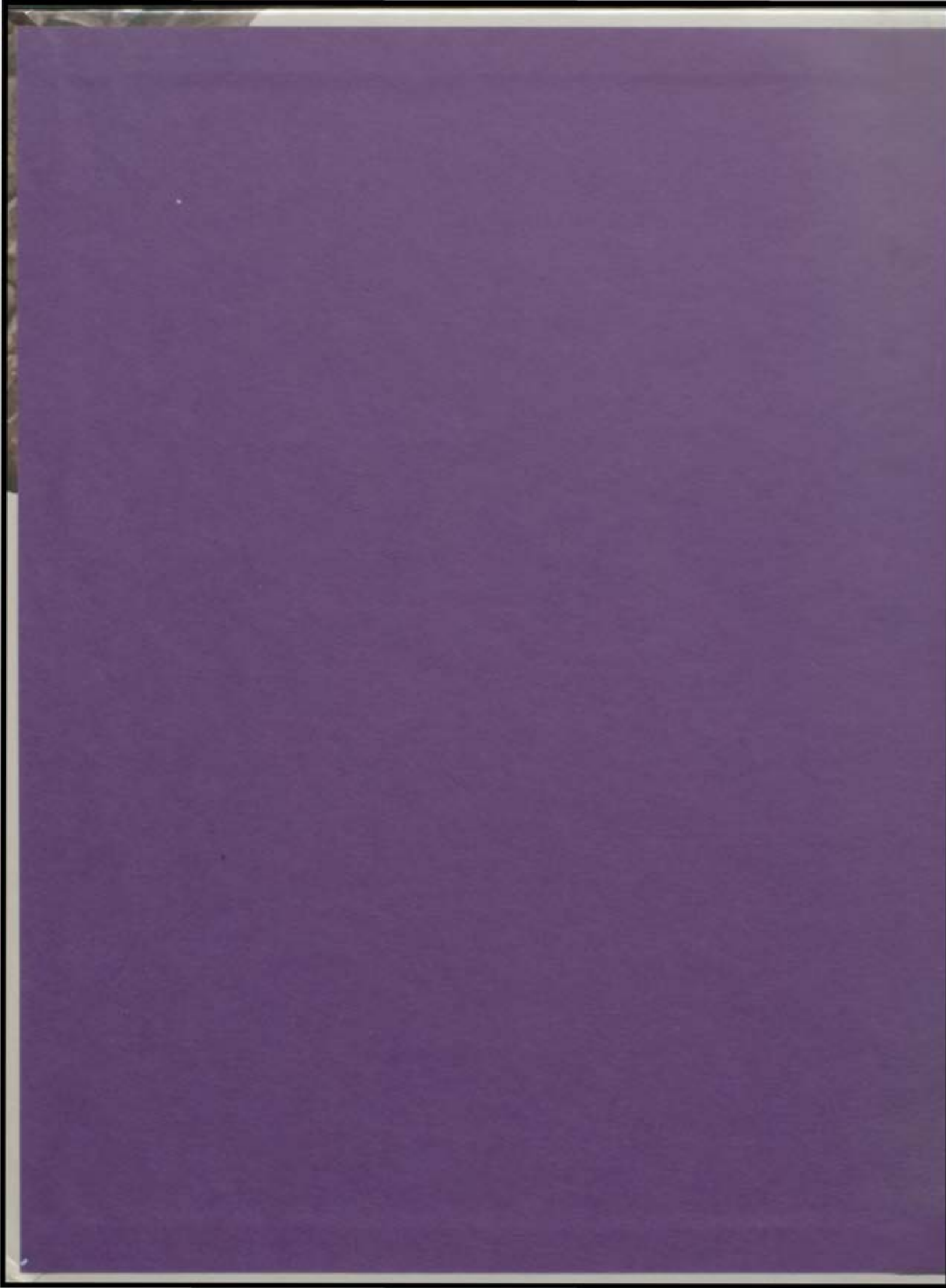

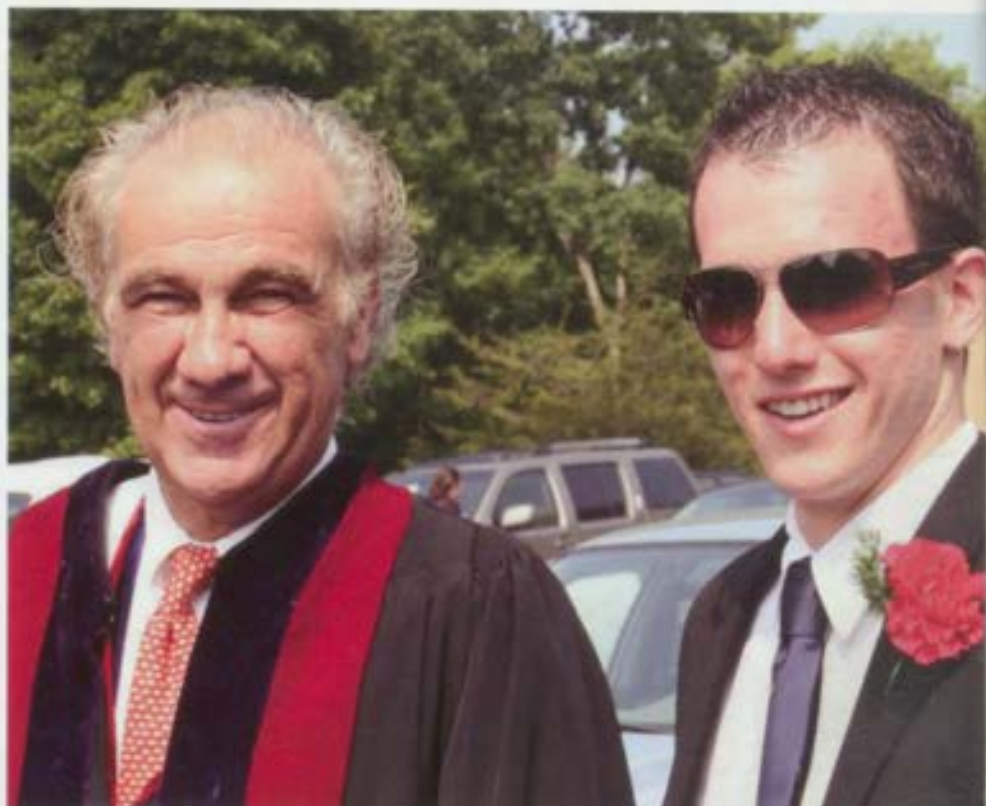
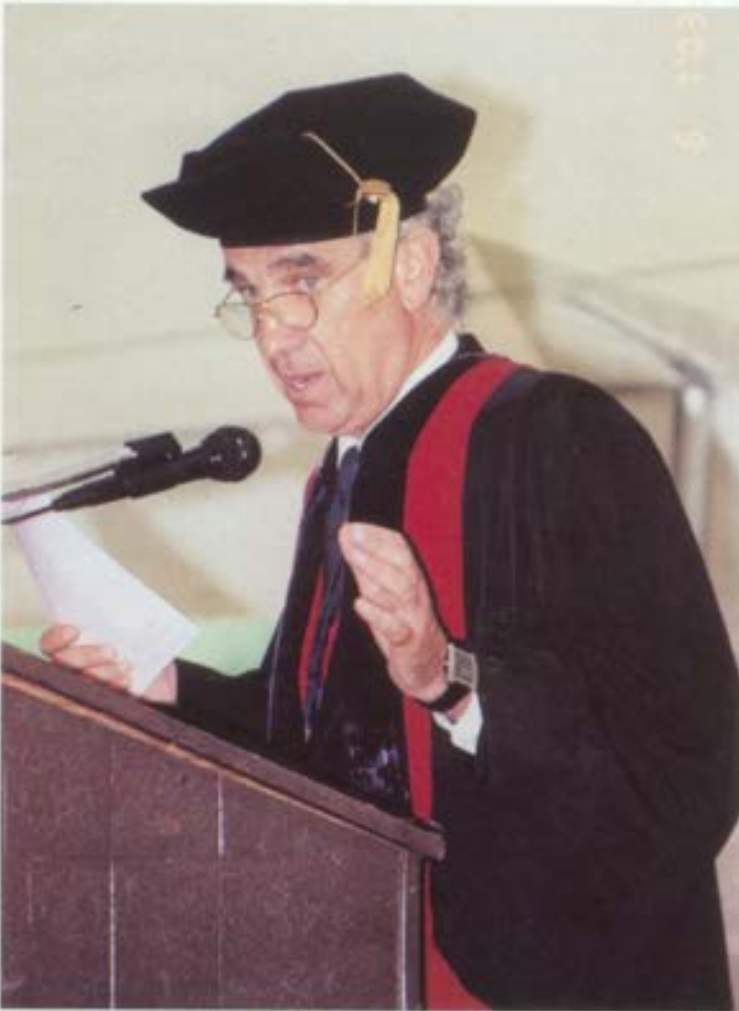
Congratulations to the Class of 2007
