

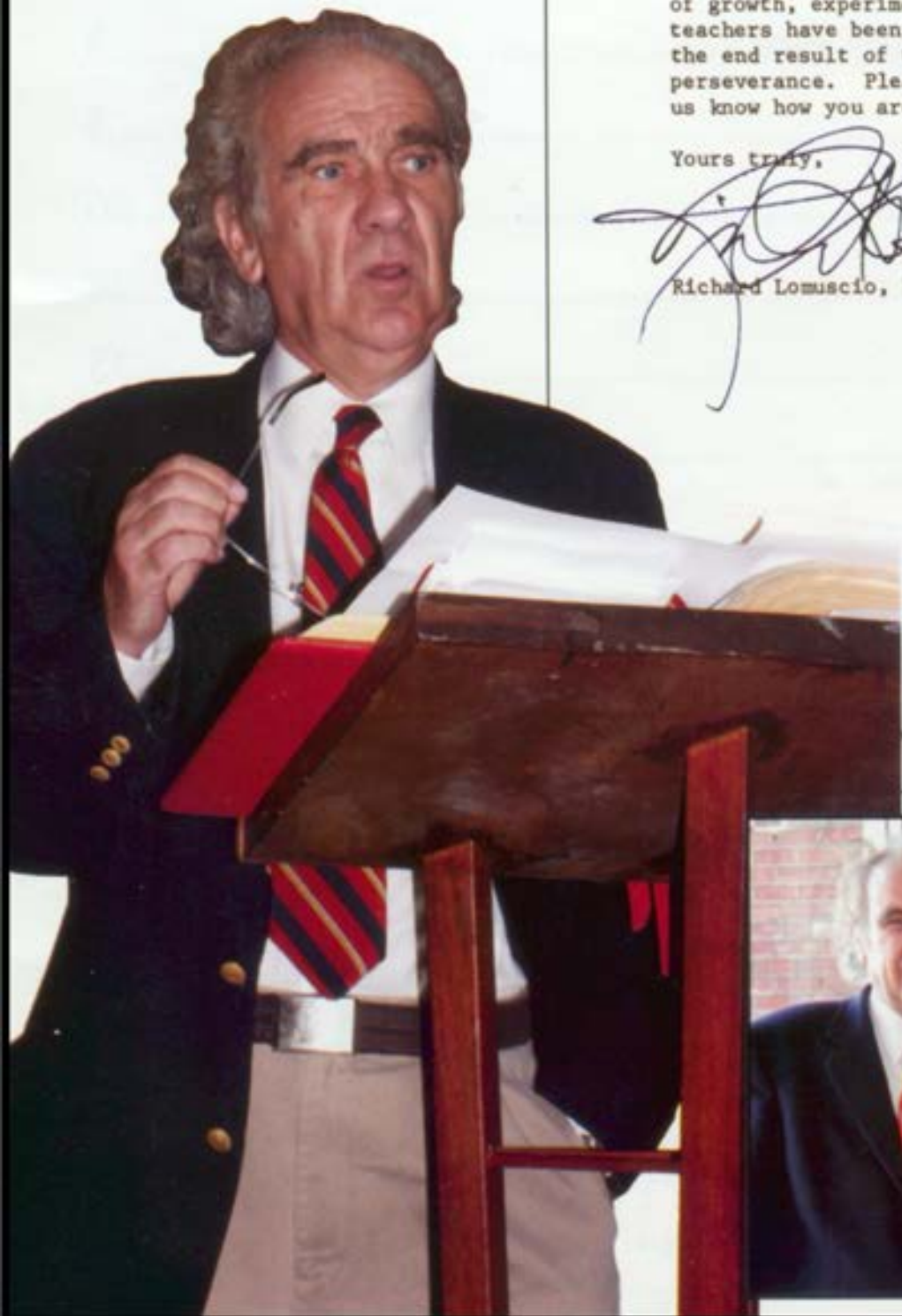
Congratulations to the Class of 2010.
