during free time using only the light from the door. These are the times that I will remember for the rest of my life.

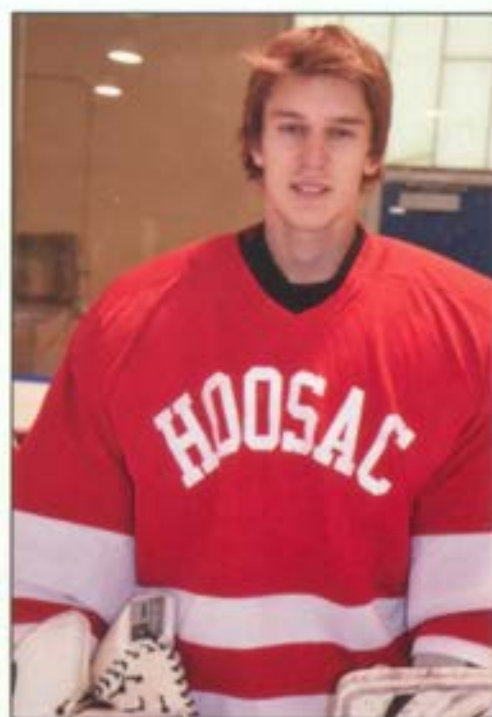

The Reverend Gavitt Memorial Window

Christ the King Chapel
Hoosac School, Hoosick, NY



Dedicated in June of 2010, the Gavitt Memorial Window was generously donated by Hoosac School Alumni, Al Keller (1956) in the memory of The Reverend Canon Loren Nichols Gavitt (2/13/1900 – 2/23/1972).

Father G, as he was widely known, graduated in 1927 from the General Theological Seminary in New York, and is fondly remembered for creating a safe and stable environment for troubled students, at the Parish of Grace and Holy Innocence Church at 498 Clinton Avenue, Albany NY, along with Fr. Reynold D. McKeown.

Father Gavitt achieved success with his students by nurturing rigorous participation in Rectory life, which required full attendance of all church and academic activities. His students were forever grateful for the second chance they were given, and the unconditional love provided in the structured and supportive environment at Grace and Holy Innocents was based on his no nonsense, New

England outlook tempered by his uncompromising generosity and unshakeable faith in mankind. Father Gavitt was also a notable scholar, with a publication of the Book of Common Prayer, and as a Seminary Instructor in the field of comparative religion, and he was a well respected clergy member of the Albany Diocese. Hoosac School Chaplain, The Reverend Canon Clinton Dugger can also be counted as one with fond memories of the Father G's accomplished life's work for his flock.

The stained glass memorial window is a depiction of Christ the King (Christus Rex) with a robed Christ on a ruby cruciform inspired by the 13th century Florentine master, Cimabue, to depict Christ's sacrifice for all, and his Passion is symbolized in the grapevine diapering in the blue background. There are two small icons that represent each Joseph of Arimethea and Simon of Cyrene. Joseph was a wealthy individual who bravely approached Pontius Pilate after the Crucifixion to request Christ's body which he then laid in his own tomb. Simon of Cyrene was called upon to help Christ carry the cross on his way to be crucified. Simon's act of sharing the burden, and Joseph's act of humility to help someone less fortunate are both supreme qualities that would symbolize the life of Father Gavitt. Two angels flank Christ and the one on the left holds a thurible or censer, and the figures are set under a gothic architectural canopy.

The window contains 180 individual pieces of mouth blown glass in a mixture of flashed glass and full antiques in variations that include the school colors. All the painted details required multiple kiln firings for the glass paint and silver stain treatments. The window was designed to create a jewel like texture to harmonize with the wonderful old masonry wall, but with restraint in order to preserve the intimacy of the chapel. It is hoped that the story of this memorial will help inspire the student body and visitors to the chapel for many generations to follow.
