TRANSGENDER PEER SUPPORT GROUPS

WHAT

Peer facilitated social support group for Trans*, non-binary, and Two Spirit people.

WHEN

3rd Wednesday of every month from 6-8:30 p.m.

AGES

18+

FAMILY CONNECTIONS

WHAT

A peer-led, drop-in family, friends, and ally support program. This is a safe space to get support walking through their loved one's transition/coming-out journey.

WHEN

2nd Wednesday of the month, 6-8 p.m.

AGES

Open to all ages.

ROTATING PROGRAMMING

WHAT

We offer various 10-week programming that includes specialized topics.

Gender Journeys: films, food and company, open to trans youth.

It's All Drag: learn about queer history, makeup, and performing!

WHEN

Thursday evenings, 6-8:30 p.m.

AGES

Varies based on program.

WEEKLY DROP-INS

Where transgender and queer people can find support and connect without barriers.

YOUTH

Monday and Tuesday evenings
4:30-7:30 p.m., Ages 11-18

A weekly program to socialize, network, discuss queer and trans issues, create art, have snacks and play games.

ADULT (QT COFFEE HAUS)

Every Thursday, 2-4 p.m.
Ages 18+

A safe space for 2SLGBTQAI+ folk to hang out, access resources, and socialize over coffee/tea and snacks.



QT CAMP

Each summer, Diversity Ed organizes QT Camp, a camp aiming to bring 40 2SLGBTQIA+ youth from across Ontario for 5 days of learning, social skill development and fun.

PRIDEFEST

A weekend long Pride Festival to honor and recognize the 2SLGBTQIA+ community, families, friends and allies. Sarnia-Lambton PrideFest takes place in the summer.
