











Jim Roberts: "It's that time of year again. *Aeschynanthus sp.* 'Thai' variegated is ready for blooming. The plant spreads close to 5 feet at the moment. All of the stem tips are showing buds. One stem has open flowers.

The pot grows in the shade house on the lanai with the aroids, Nepenthes, Flytraps and miscellaneous other plants. As you can see, a fern has decided to share its pot.

Side note: shared a cutting with a friend last year at this time. No problems rooting it. He also potted up a leaf that had broken off and it sent up a variegated plant."
