## Simple Chemo Beanie

- A Crochet Hat Pattern by Mamta Motiyani 2010

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## Description:

I designed this hat for my crochet team, "CreateCrochet" on Etsy so we could make hats to donate to "Relay for Life". It's a basic chemo hat so anyone with fair knowledge of crochet can make it.

The beanie can be made using either aran weight yarn or bulky weight yarn.
Version 1 of this hat can be is made with Aran weight yarn.
Version 2 of this hat can be is made with Bulky weight yarn.

## Abbreviations:(US terminology)

ch/s - chain/ chains
dc - double crochet
st/s - stitch/stitches
sl st - slip stitch
beg - beginning
rep - repeat
yds - yards
oz - ounces
g - grams
mm- millimetre
cm - centimeter

## Materials:

## Version 1:

Lion brand Cotton Ease( $50 \%$ cotton, $50 \%$ acrylic; 207 yds[188m]/3.5 oz [100 g]; CYCA \#4): \#830-134 Terracotta, 1(1, 2, 2) skeins.

OR
Any Aran / 10 ply/ 8 wpi weight yarn - about $80-125 \mathrm{~g}(3-5 \mathrm{oz})$

## Version 2:

ICE Filzy Wool (100\% Wool; 109 yds[100 m]/3.53 oz [100 g]; CYCA \#5): \#26010, Turquoise; $1(1,2,2)$ skeins.

OR

Any Bulky weight yarn - about 125-150 g( 5-6 oz)

## Crochet Hook:

## Version 1:

US G/6(4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## Version 2:

US 7(4.50 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## Notions:

Sewing needle
Stitch Marker

## Gauge:

## Version 1:

4 dc and 2 dc rows $=1$ " with US G/6 $(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hook.

## Version 2:

3 sts and 3 rows $=1 "$ with US $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hook.

## Finished Sizes:

Circumference: 12" - 14", Height: 5"
Circumference: 14" - 16", Height: 5.5"
Circumference: 16" - 18", Height: 6.5"
Circumference: 18" - 20", Height: 7"
Circumference: 20" - 22", Height: 8"
Circumference: 22" - 24", Height: 9"

## Pattern Notes:

All the stitches are worked in both loops of stitches unless otherwise stated. Place a stitch marker in the beginning stitch of each round for ease in counting stitches. You may change the color of yarn on any row to make it a multi colored hat. Explore your imagination!

## Version 1:

## Size 12"-14":

Rnd 1: Ch 4(counts as beg dc), 11 dc in beg ch, sl st in 4th ch of the beg ch-4. (12 sts)
Rnd 2: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in same sp as beg ch 3, 2 dc in next 11 sts , sl st in beg ch-3. (24 sts)

Rnd 3: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), 2 dc in next st, *dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. ( 36 sts)

Rnd 4 : Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next $2 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (48 sts)

Rnd 5: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (54 sts)

Rnd 6-Rnd 9: : Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (54 sts)
Row 10: Rep Rnd 6, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (54 sts)
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## Size 14" - 16":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 3 as in Size 12" - 14" (36 sts)
Rnd 4 : Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (48 sts)

Rnd 5: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (60 sts)

Rnd 6: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 9 sts, 2 dc in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (66 dc)

Rnd 7-Rnd 10: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (66 sts)
Row 11: Rep Rnd 7, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (66 sts)

## Size 16" - 18":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 4 as in Size 14" - 16" (48 sts)
Rnd 5: Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (60 sts)

Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in ch 3 in the beg. ( 72 sts)

Rnd 7-Rnd 12: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (72 sts)
Row 13: Rep Rnd 7, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (72 sts)

## Size 18" - 20":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 6 as in Size 16" - 18" (72 sts)
Rnd 7: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 10 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next $11 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. ( 78 dc )

Rnd 8 - Rnd 13: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (78 sts)
Row 14: Rep Rnd 8, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (78 sts)

## Size 20" - 22":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 6 as in Size 16" - 18" (72 sts)
Rnd 6: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (84 dc)

Rnd 7- Rnd 15: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (84 sts)
Row 16: Rep Rnd 7, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (84 dc)

## Size 22" - 24":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 6 as in Size 20" - 22" (84 sts)
Rnd 7 : Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (96 dc)

Rnd 8-Rnd 17: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (96 sts)
Row 18: Rep Rnd 8, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (96 sts)

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## Version 2:

Size 12" - 14":
Rnd 1: Ch 4(counts as beg dc), 11 dc in beg ch, sl st in 4th ch of the beg ch-4. (12 sts)
Rnd 2: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in same sp as beg ch 3, 2 dc in next 11 sts , sl st in beg ch-3. (24 sts)

Rnd 3: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), 2 dc in next st, *dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. ( 36 sts )

Rnd 4: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (42 sts)

Rnd 5-Rnd 9: : Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (42 sts)
Row 10: Rep Rnd 5, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (42 sts)

Size 14" - 16":
Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 3 as in Size 12" - 14" (36 sts)
Rnd 4 : Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (48 sts)

Rnd 5-Rnd 10: : Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (48 sts)
Row 11: Rep Rnd 5, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (48 sts)

## Size 16" - 18":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 4 as in Size 14" - 16" (48 sts)

Rnd 5: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. ( 54 sts )

Rnd 6-Rnd 12: : Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (54 sts)
Row 13: Rep Rnd 6, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (54 sts)

## Size 18" - 20":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 4 as in Size 14" - 16" (48 sts)
Rnd 5: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. (60 sts)

Rnd 6 - Rnd 13: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (60 sts)
Row 14: Rep Rnd 6, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (60 sts)

## Size 20" - 22":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 5 as in Size 18" - 20" (60 sts)

Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st, $*$ dc in next 9 sts, 2 dc in next st, rep from * till the end, sl st in beg ch-3. ( 66 dc )

Rnd 7-Rnd 13: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (66 sts)
Row 15: Rep Rnd 7, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. ( 66 dc )

## Size 22"-24":

Rep Rnd 1 - Rnd 5 as in Size 18" - 20" (60 sts)
Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st, $*$ dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * till the end, sl st in ch 3 in the beg. ( 72 sts)

Rnd 7-Rnd 15: Ch 3(counts as beg dc), dc in each st till the end. (72 sts)
Row 16: Rep Rnd 7, fasten off and weave in ends with a sewing needle. (72 sts)
