

Accommodation

The centre offers accommodation which gives people great access to the water and activities.

Standard rooms – comprise of bunk beds and a single bed. Each room also has a sink. Along the corridor there are shared bathroom and shower facilities. There are 19 rooms in total across 2 floors.



Ensuite Bedrooms – the centre offers 7 ensuite rooms.







Room rate also includes breakfast.

Costs for 2024 are:

Standard rooms £70 per night

Ensuite £82.50 per night

Premier ensuites £93.50 per night

There are no cooking facilities available, and people are not permitted to bring cooking supplies to cook in the building at all.

With regards to the "Common areas or shared living rooms" we do not have dedicated areas for this, however, there is a room attached to the cafe, the Ocean room, that is accessible to all. There will be an event marquee out for everyone to congregate in.
