Program Overview

This course offers a full, one-year apprenticeship in Landscape Maintenance. The training involves various methods and procedures in lawn care involving shrubs, trees, flowers, ground covers, and container plants. Participants also learn to seed and sod lawns, how to use mulch, fertilizers, apply herbicides, fungicides and insecticides. Participants will also perform Horticulture tasks to interior/exterior gardens and landscapes using machinery and hand tools, as well as regulating, controlling, repairing and maintaining sprinkler and irrigation systems.
