## **EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE**

- 1. **Pennsylvania Military Educational Assistance Program** -PA National Guard member to be eligible. It is a non-taxable grant. It is offer to the member for a 6-year enlistment commitment. If you attend Commonwealth Member Institution it pays 100%. Any other college it off sets the tuition. It will pay more than \$5,038 per year for up to 5 years.
- 2. PA National Guard Education Assistance Program Only first lieutenants and below in rank are eligible. Full-time student, equal to or greater than 12chs per semester up to \$2313 per state fiscal year. Part-time student more than 3 chs but less than 12 chs per semester up to \$1156.
- 3. Continuing Education Scholarship must be a member of VFW Auxiliary (Member, Spouse, Son, Daughter). Four 1,000 scholarships will be awarded each year. February 15<sup>th</sup> deadline for all applicants.
- 4. **Sports Clips Help A Hero Scholarship** eligible to service members and veterans. Up to \$5,000. Must demonstrate a need for financial assistance. Must be an E-5 or below. Must be a VA approved school.
- 5. American Legion Legacy Scholarship needs based scholarship to fulfill a financial gap after all other scholarships are used. Post 9/11 children of military members who died on active duty or 9/11 veterans with a rating disability of 50%. Up to \$20,000 in aid for undergraduate or post-graduate college. Can apply up to 6 times. The application deadline is April 15.
