Stacia Alyea was a member of Leadership Hancock County's inaugural class, in 1996. She was well-regarded by her classmates, who noted her commitment to her community, her family and her career as a member of the Shelby County Sheriff's Department.

In April 1996, near the end of her year in Leadership, Stacia, 35, was killed in an accident during a pursuit of a drunken driver. She had received an award from Mothers Against Drunk Driving the week before for her work in drunken driving enforcement. Her Leadership class created the Excellence in Leadership Award to honor her memory. The first award was made in 1997. The annual award recognizes an individual from the class who shows outstanding leadership qualities. Criteria are those that Stacia best exemplified:

- A balanced commitment to community, home and work
- A passion for improving life circumstances
- Dedication to improving the lives of others
- Integrity, dedication, candor and compassion

The award is perhaps most meaningful to its recipients because it is voted on by fellow class members.
