WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Individuals who live or work in Hancock County and have a desire to become more involved in their community, wish to expand their knowledge of local issues, or want to develop more effective leadership skills. Participant must be 18 years or older to participate.

PROGRAM FEES

- The cost of the program is **\$725.00**. (Cash/Check)
- Fees are due **September 6, 2024**. Participants are usually recommended and sponsored by their employers or by a civic organization. However, individuals are welcome to apply.
- Payments are final. No refunds are allowed.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Retreat days are mandatory. Participants who are unable to attend will not be permitted to continue with the current class and should not apply.
- To graduate, participants must complete all course assignments and attend all scheduled classes. Typical class days run from 8 am – 5 pm.
- If you are forced to be absent from one class, the employer (or individual paying tuition) shall be notified, and participant must make up that particular class session the following year to receive graduation recognition.
- If you are forced to be absent for a second class, your employer (or individual paying tuition) will be invoiced \$75.00 to accommodate both classes the next year.
- Any additional absences may be the cause for dismissal from the program and tuition fee will be forfeited. If you want to participate again, you will need to submit a new application and tuition fee.
