



FOREWORD

This article is focused upon this month's theme that addresses, in part, the following questions: *When did you first believe? Do you remember your calling; your purpose; your place in God? Do you know or remember your assignment?*

First Believe

From being a child to adulthood, it is important and vital to one's soul to believe in God and to serve Him in Spirit and in Truth. If not applicable to you, perhaps someone you know is in dire need of hearing or receiving an unadulterated message or a Word from God. Perhaps this is *your purpose—to teach*. Just as important, ensure, if you can, that the learner, especially one who is new to the Lord, is being taught by a God-fearing individual whose teaching is in alignment with the Word of God. One should not simply leave it up to someone else to ensure that, for example, a loved one is being spiritually fed according to the Holy Scriptures. It may be good to know for oneself, again, if possible, to ensure that a learner is not receiving tainted ideologies that are contrary to the Living Word.

As a child, I can recall one particular Sunday School session—mainly this one session. After a couple or so sessions, my parents no longer sent me back; maybe it was discontinued—*I do not know.* I believe I may have expressed my displeasure towards being in these sessions. I can recall being around pre-school age. I can recall being told that due to structural damage to the church we attended, I would attend Sunday School in a neighbor's home. Upon attending the Sunday School sessions, I quickly learned that I, and perhaps maybe a few other children as well, were not the apple of this Sunday School teacher's eye. What I remember is that I and the other little children were huddled in a small pantry area, and yet in spite of our closeness, the teacher only gave her attention to one or two of us out of what seemed like a group of at least seven. It is unfortunate that instead of remembering

scriptures and lessons presented in the Holy Bible, I remember the schisms expressed during this particular Sunday School lesson. As an adult, many, many, years later, I realized what was happening; it was unfortunate. This is what I first remembered. This is what I learned the most—that even as a young child—I learned that there are schisms, or more accurately—favoritism in the church. I felt as though there was a strong disconnect, to put it mildly. What a shame. For my early years of attending *church*, that is what I first learned to believe.

To emphasize: One should do their best to learn what is going on around children; whether toddlers, young scholars, or college graduates. Certain actions by superiors can be everlasting—and emotionally harmful. Adult intervention and support is essential; however, and as you know, from adults who possess compassion, empathy, and Godly love, so that you know with good conscience that your loved one, friend, or familiar acquaintance is in good hands.

Fast forwarding: As a young adult in my 20's, I can remember taking the Holy Bible that my Mom bought for me and started reading it. I am grateful that I still have it to this day; although very worn—hardly touched due to the accessibility of the biblical scriptures on the internet. I share this information because although I knew that there is a God; that we should worship Him and His Son, it was with this same Holy Bible that I can recall a specific event in my life that I knew I believed in God and our Lord Jesus, but was not forthright in heart. I can recall going on public transportation and hiding what I was reading; as though it were unpopular to bring the Word out in public. *I don't know why—but I believe there was an eclipse in my heart about openly reading God's Word*. I knew that I was drawn to knowing God, but my heart was convicted—*was I ashamed? God forbid*. I remember sitting down and it was as clear as day that while my intentions were good, my heart was not yet right. What a shame.

Fast forwarding again to later stages of my adulthood: I developed the maturity to learn what it means to trust in Jesus; to trust God; albeit due to very difficult experiences. As I learned to trust in Him, I grew to yearn for His divine intervention in my life. I developed a hunger and thirst to worship Him. I went from ministry to ministry. Back in the day, church fellowship and church networking was grand! There was not a week that I can remember during those years that would go by that there was not an invitation coming my way to attend a church service. Unfortunately, that was also the beginning of problems. As a result of my church-hopping, I exposed myself to situations I was not prepared for. To sum it all up—spiritual wickedness in high places.

What led me to truly know about the power of my Lord and my God took place during various paradigm shifts in my life induced by tragedy; a failed relationship, and more...*but God has a plan...and He has a plan for you, too. If you have not as yet, received His divine plan and purpose for your life; please do so now and receive your calling.* You may not understand it at first, but knowing the power of God, and by the power of the Holy Spirit, He will enable you to understand His plan for your life better as time goes by. To add, love yourself and appreciate more of what you have. Appreciate another day to grow closer to Him and to worship Him. You will find peace and joy if you love the Lord and your God. You will find deliverance, if you desire to be free from the bondage of this world.

John 15:20 ~ ²⁰ Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

Spiritual Gifts Our Strengths

Gifts are just that—*gifts! They are not earned.* Yet, multitudes who possess *spiritual gifts* will not acknowledge the Creator or give Him due respect and honor. Some will even abuse their spiritual gifts—I used to refer to it as a form of spiritual prostitution. I have learned that many will use their gifts in ways that can make one shutter. Also, those with a prophetic mantel on their life may exercise the gift of prophesy, but will use his or her gift to tap into someone's life to manipulate; to covet. Some will use other devices that are not within the Will of God to fulfill their own selfish desires. *Don't be that person!*

To emphasize: Our Lord is truly The Gift-Giver. It is important to respect and understand that. Whether one is Black, White, Jew, Gentile—we all have gifts in various strengths and levels—like and as diverse as the human body that has many members and specialties. To emphasize, it is important to know when and how to use one's gift. Being led by the Holy Spirit is extremely important in order to stir up the gifts from within—whether it is to fight the good fight of faith, to deter and eliminate the temptation to give up or give in, or when the going gets tough for you and for others.

Ephesians 6:11-12 ~ ¹¹ Put on the whole armour of God, that you [we] may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

The Fire Within; Then To The Flood, And Back Again

I remember way back how worship and praise services were in full force and effect in grand style. The circle of Believers I used to be closely in contact with were so involved and so engaged. What a joy it was to go to church revivals! Some times for straight weeks; almost every day after work...almost with total disregard to inclement weather. Had car, was traveling! When I think about how I used to travel from ministry to ministry—WOW! In similar fashion to how some partied and hung out—the church became my place. What almost put a complete halt to that? I learned the hard way that not every place is meant to go to, even if it is or was considered a Christian place of worship. I learned that my purpose was not to share my gifts, my talents—my presence—with just anyone or anybody. Yet, through what I learned, albeit painful at times, it was for my good because I realized over a series of experiences over the years that God has a plan and purpose for me. Most importantly, no man, woman, or child will be able to take or steal His glory for seeing me through the most arduous periods of my life.

The fire within me back then was fueled by a desire to learn more and more about my purpose in God. I would travel for miles to attend what I hoped would be Holy Ghost filled and fire baptized services. I can recall that there were services by different messengers morning, noon, and night. I can remember the fire within—I remember the enormous energy and drive I had to worship God—to be more than a person sitting on a pew. Unfortunately, for certain circles of fellowship, I realized that all who are gifted do not use their gifts to God's glory. That some—from the pulpit to the pews—would attempt to lead the Lord's sheep astray. What a shame.

The fire within for serving the Lord was almost being doused out—to be replaced by extreme disappointment and separation from fellow worshippers. I am grateful and humbled

to indicate 'almost'—the adversary is a liar, and I know that because in spite of all that I was exposed to, it was God who Is my stay. I know who God is to me, and that He has a plan for me—and I will touch and agree in the Spirit for you the same. Tell the adversary in your life or anything that is contrary to the Will of God, under the power and unction of the Holy Spirit, that it is a defeated foe! Declare the adversary is under your feet! Don't accept defeat or listen to his lies.

Jeremiah's Plea

Jeremiah 20: 7-10 ~ ⁷O Lord, You induced me, and I was persuaded; You are stronger than I, and have prevailed. I am in derision daily; everyone mocks me. ⁸ For when I spoke, I cried out; I shouted, *Violence and plunder!* because the word of the Lord was made to me a reproach and a derision daily.
⁹ Then I said, *I will not make mention of Him, Nor speak anymore in His name.* But His word was in my heart like a burning fire shut up in my bones; I was weary of holding it back, and I could not. ¹⁰ For I heard many mocking: *Fear on every side!* '*Report*,' they say, *and we will report it!* All my acquaintances watched for my stumbling, saying, '*Perhaps he can be induced; Then we will prevail against him, and we will take our revenge on him.*'

Are you able to identify with God's servant, Jeremiah? I remember back in the day, I have not heard this for years, but God's servant, Jeremiah, was called *The Crying Prophet.* Can you identify with his hurt, his disappointments, or even his fears? As the Word of God will teach us, because we are God's chosen vessels and are a part of His divine plan, does not equate that at all times our lives will be easy. What our Lord and our God promises is that we will have everlasting life—we will be blessed with His gift of salvation. As Believers and worshippers, we are designed and created to fulfill His plan and purpose; He will be faithful to see us through...one way or another as we stay the course and not go astray. We are the sheep of His pasture; He is the Potter, we are the clay.

Needless to share, but good to remember, not all situations are transparent. A *lesson learned will sometimes evolve without even realizing one is being taught!* Sometimes, looking things over and reflecting can make one realize that much more—*My God! I know you have your hands on me! You got me through this...you got me through that!* Sometimes, I feel as though I do not know certain particulars and specifics of my plan and purpose in God, but this I know for sure...God is real...His Son Jesus lives...and His Holy Spirit guides me, and that He love me; I am His child.

Ephesians 4:11-16 ~ ¹¹ And He Himself gave some to be, prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers,¹² for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the body of Christ,¹³ till we all come to the unity of the faith of the knowledge of the Son of God, to perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;¹⁴ that we should no longer be tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of plotting,¹⁵ but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the—Christ—¹⁶ from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

Do Not Stray From The Old Landmark

It's July 2020. Do you remember when or where you first believed? If you asked me, I would not be able to answer—it would be just impossible for me to remember when I first believed. Too many years past, but I do remember significant events in my life that made a profound impact upon my life that brought me closer to the Lord...and even knowing this, I would not be able to narrow it down to a particular day, week, month, or year. I believe it is

best that way; perhaps knowing too many details and all the particulars would be the cause of additional distractions in my walk with God.

Matthew 17:4-6 ~ ⁴ Then Peter answered and said to Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, let us make here three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah. ⁵ While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, *This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!* ⁶ And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their faces and were greatly afraid.⁷ But Jesus came and touched them and said, *Arise, and do not be afraid.*

Have you ever thought about what it would have been like to know the true birth date of Jesus? Have you ever wondered what it would have been like to know His exact...and I mean exact birth location pertaining to where He was laid in the manger? Image if the world knew. We probably would enshrine the location, thereby taking away the true essence of why Jesus came to this world in the flesh in the first place. Oh, that's right! There's December 25th! My point is that recollecting upon when we first believed may be important for some, if not most Believers, because we may be able to associate when we first believed to a moment in time when our passion for Christ was strong. Reflecting upon when we first placed our sincere trust in God may rekindle our love for our Lord and our God that may enhance the fire from within. Remembering when we first believed might remind us why, in the first place, of the importance of continuously developing a heart and a made up mind to worship God in Spirit and in Truth. Remembering when we first believed may encourage us to stay encouraged and to give up, feel defeated, or worn out by what seems to be so prominent—the rejections, cruelties, and the harshness of this world. However significant our old landmark was, it is not as important as where we are today. What matters is that we have a made up mind and are sold out for the cause of Christ—*right*?

What matters most is how we exercise our faith, how we run our race, and how we finish the course. What is important is that God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life (John 3:16). What is important is that we share the gospel according to the teachings of Christ Jesus as His Holy Spirit empowers us. What is important is to fulfill God's purpose for our lives while remaining on the right side of Him. Praying, fasting, worshipping Him with a clean and sincere heart and a renewed heart for Him. What is important for us to remember is the significance of fellowshipping with one another for inspiration; spreading the gospel—looking back only because it is humbling to know how far God brought us—and how much farther we may need to go in Him. *To God be the glory forever and forever more*.

He knows me...He knows you. He knew us before the foundation of the world. He remembered those God placed in His care (His disciples) during His prayer, as well as those who are to come; His remnant (us). He remembered the world as He sweated both blood and water during His prayer as He prepared to set His face

towards His false accusers. 

"Remembering When I First Believed, My Salvation, My Purpose, and My Calling; It's Time to Get Back in Place and Build!"

A very powerful preacher recently said, "the church is in trouble. The church is in trouble not because of sin, but because we do not know how to use the POWER of GOD that we have within us." He went on to say God wants to bless us with ultimate blessings, but he will not override our decisions to be disobedient. The preacher had my attention at point one 'the church is in trouble.' Because I had been 'in trouble' for quite some time.

At the beginning of this year, I was asked if I had learned anything last year in 2019 and if so, would I be taking that into the new year 2020? I pray the lessons I have learned not only in 2019 but in my life altogether, will be life changing for me and beneficial to all I will ever encounter now, and for the rest of my Years ago, when I first got saved, my approach to demonic attack or life. demonic trespass I would immediately deal with by fasting and praying. This was done almost effortlessly because at that time, my relationship with God I did not compromise it for no one. I knew of the power of God within me and I knew the enemy had no authority over me because I am God's child. And so, I stayed close to God through prayer and followed His command for everything. Also, at that time I had no turned around collar, no title, and no aspiration to become a titled individual. I just loved God, and I loved and believed His Word! I believed Mark 16:17-"And these signs shall follow them that believe, "In my name shall they cast out devils;" and during any demonic attack, after fasting and praying, and seeking God's face, I'd cast out devils according to His word and they would flee.

That was the POWER of God working within me, I give Him all the glory. But the TROUBLE with this fact is, most people who knew me "in the church," did not know this fact concerning me. That's a problem! Because these "gifts" are needed in the church and wherever God should lead or send me. I say this not to be braggadocios or abased, but in trying to "do good," and in trying to be obedient to "do ministry," of what I thought was right, this became contrary to the will of God for many years and during those years, I was miserable.

God wants Relationship with us! When Adam and Eve sinned in the garden and hid themselves, the first thing God asked Adam was, "where art thou?"

Many believe they are in the will of God and have a relationship with Him because they are obedient to their Pastor or to their church or with their busy schedule. But if you have no relationship with the Lord, at some point your will is going to become contrary to His will and you will lose your place in God and your power too just as I did. I became bound.

I tried being "obedient" and committed to so many "other" things and so many people without continuing my relationship with God first, and in so doing, I lost the power that I had so easily known of Him. So, this is what I have learned, it is sinful to override God's will with your own even when we believe we're doing a greater good. When we sacrifice disobedience for God's perfect will, it will not matter what we do thereafter because you will be stuck and "out of order."

You know that feeling you have when you feel miserable and nothing seems to satisfy that feeling and you don't know why? And nothing seems to fill that void? Check your RELATIONSHIP with God. It could be "off balance" while you're still "doing ministry" and God is not going to override our decisions of disobedience, we must be willing to allow Him to lead and guide us.

I see many Christians professing to "know" Jesus but have no attributes of Him at all. But the authenticity of God's gifts within us are still genuine and undisputed. Whatever your gift is, or whatever your "Ministry" is, no one will be able to execute that gift like you! Because God has specifically designed you, and directed the trials of your life, which in actuality, will strengthen you to excellently execute that gift! Remember, **Romans 8:28-"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to** *his* **purpose.**

Although I was able to cast out devils in the name of Jesus Christ, I still did not know God's purpose for that gift! And as the issues of life occurred, I prayed less, lost focus of God and lost a lot of time. I thank God that He is not a man that He should lie because all the things that I went through, he did work them together insomuch that today His purpose and my calling are undeniable! Now I know my "place," my ministry, and what it is for!

The Lord will fortify you for "Ministry", but you've got to "know" Him and know what His purpose is for your life. The Lord has enlarged my territories and my vision is clear about what I am to do. I still have a lot of work to do but God has invigorated me, and it's now time to get back in place and build up His Kingdom!

"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things." – Philippians 4:8 (King James Version)

What is thought? It is an idea or an opinion that is produced by thinking; an action of something processed in the mind. When we look at the above scripture we could see one or two things: 1) The Apostle Paul was teaching how to think positive or have positive thoughts or 2) the Apostle Paul was teaching on how to develop their thinking ability that would help produce a better outcome in life.

I don't find it strange that the Apostle gave a specific foundation of list of things for us to consider or to ponder on. I believe that he had to do this because the problem with thoughts are that one single wrong thought can cause a person's life to spiral completely out of control. He understood why it was important to think on certain things. The enemy would come and bring up old deadly past events of life to get us to think on them. The longer we think on them, they can draw us into an area of depression down to the point where we become emotionally, physically, mentally and even spiritually paralyzed. As long as we think on things that are unproductive and can bring us into the yoke of bondage, we can't operate in the spirit of righteousness and power. We were warned not to become entangled with the yoke of bondage. What is your yoke of bondage that you must be aware and careful of?

Have you ever noticed how you could be having a wonderful and peaceful day, and then all of a sudden a thought from the past will pop up? When that thought pops up, do we do what the scripture says in 2 Corinthians 10:5 *"Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ"*? The word of God never tells us to dwell on the past. The word of God does not tell us to live in past failures or problems. No, it does not. The word tells us to Cast down and bring into captivity (everything) that exalteth itself against the scalar the *knowledge* of **GOD**. What is the knowledge of God to you?

The Apostle Paul admonishes us to direct our thoughts towards things that are *true*, *honest*, *just*, *pure*, *lovely*, and are of a *good report*. If we do that, then those thoughts will produce virtue and bring God praise.

First, we must recognize when we are being drawn into dwelling on the past and not thinking on things that are pleasing and acceptable to God. We must learn to recognize, grab hold, cast down and bring into captivity those deadly and poisonous thoughts. Once we get into that habit, our thoughts, as well as our speech can line up together, and we will begin to see the blessing of having good seed in the heart and mind.

Let me share this other thing with you from scripture. Let us turn our attention to Philippians 2:5 – "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus" In order for us to have the mind of Christ who was always mindful of Father's Will, we must comply with Romans 12:1-2 – "... present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, acceptable, and perfect, will of God (the FATHER). How do we renew our minds so that we could think on the things that the Apostle Paul told us to? Ephesians 5:26 says, "That He (Jesus Christ) might sanctify and cleanse it (us, the church) with the washing of water by the word". We must not only read and not only study the Word of God, but we must bring ourselves to a place that we apply and do what the Word of God tells us to do. Being obedient to the Word of God allows the Holy Spirit to lead us into the paths of righteousness. He will help us keep our minds stayed on God. He, the Holy Spirit, and not "IT" will help us seek the kingdom of God and HIS righteousness. This all has to do with thought. Do we think about serving God in the spirit of godliness? Do we think about praying for those that have mistreated us? Do we think of where God brought us from? Do we think about how God kept us and someone else witnessed the change and came to God? Do we think of things that are pure, lovely, holy, glorious, and wonderful; things that bring God glory and praise? What is your thought today?

If your thoughts are not lining up with the word of God, it's time for your heart and mind to be purged. It's time for a cleansing. It's time for the heart of man to take a bath in the WORD and SPIRIT of the God.

Pay attention to the thought that draws you away from God and not to God. Pay attention to what shifts your thought process throughout your day. Sometimes it is not other people, it is I in you that should not be speaking at all; only the Holy Spirit.

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
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A Prayer for Our Nation
