

Revelation 21:1-8* ~ ¹ Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. ² Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. ³ And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God. ⁴ And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away. ⁵ Then He who sat on the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And He said to me, Write, for these words are true and faithful. ⁶ And He said to me, It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. ⁵ He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. ⁶ But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

Introduction

The theme for this month is *Standing in the doorway at the threshold into the New Room.* Initially, I could not determine the path in which to go that I thought would be inspiring to others. However, and eventually, thoughts began to come my way that kindled a message that I hope will, in turn, inspire you, the reader, to know God and His Son, Jesus, more. As it is written, *Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.* (2 Timothy 2:15; Kings James Version.) It is my hope that you will read the scriptures for yourself to confirm that what is shared in my article. Needless to share, and just as important, that is just what God desires and requires of us.

As is my custom, I like to break down the theme so as to provide a better understanding of my message. So, here I go.

Standing: Physically | An Affirmation | Reputation

Standing, or taking a stand, can mean: (1) that one is upright with the use of his or her feet (physical); (2) that he or she is taking a stance pertaining to a matter of the heart or conscience (an affirmation); and (3) a description of one's character (reputation). (A negative standing would be, for example, someone of *ill repute*.) Additional examples:

Physical: They are standing in front of the garage doorway.

Affirmatively: We are standing in the need of prayer.

Reputably: This physician's standing among his peers is truly impressive.

Having shared the above examples, I have decided to take *all three of these concepts* into consideration for this month's theme, *Standing in the doorway at the threshold into the New Room.*

Matthew 6:5 \sim 5 And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward.

Ephesians 6:10-16 ~ ¹⁰ Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. ¹³ Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵ and having shod your feet with the preparation of

the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

John 8:44 ~ ⁴⁴ You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

Many Are Called, Few Are Chosen

It is written, **Many are called, but few are chosen** (Matthew 22:14). According to the Holy Scriptures, many are called, but few are chosen because God allows humankind the freedom to choose spiritual life or spiritual death. Unfortunately, multitudes will gravitate to matters of the flesh which is at enmity to the Spirit of Christ (The Book of Romans 8). To receive spiritual life is to accept Jesus The Christ, as one's personal Lord and Savior. To accept spiritual life is to acknowledge Jesus as the Son of the Living God. To deny that He is the Son of God is to deny God Himself. To the peril of one's soul, to deny God is to deny the power of the Holy Spirit, The Comforter (John 14:16).

Before Jesus left the earth in the natural, before His crucifixion, He not only gave witness to His Father, but also taught and warned His disciples of the importance of the Believer's relationship to God the Father and Holy Spirit. Jesus taught that to go against God and to speak against the Holy Spirit is to speak condemnation against oneself. So, if one is to be considered God's chosen vessel, one must not only accept Him for who He Is, but all of Him—His Son, Jesus, and The Holy Spirit—collectively, The Holy Trinity. To deny The Holy Trinity is to deny oneself of spiritual life and peace.

Many are called, but few are chosen, because many will want to appease their spirit of self-gratification (James 1:20-22). Many believe that to live a holy life is equated with a life void of pleasure and prosperity. Of course, there are varying pleasures; not all are meant to feed the flesh or will cause disgrace upon a Christian's walk in God. Yet, what the multitudes who turn away from God focus upon is that God does not promote worldly values—and rightly so—The Holy Word clearly expresses how worldly desires can hinder one's spiritual walk in God. Excessive focus upon worldly values can cause us to lose focus upon what God desires in our walk in Him. God wants us to be blessed and favored—that we are right now—but our purpose in God is to win souls for the His kingdom. There should not be any thing greater than knowing that one is saving souls. Multitudes equate the Christian walk with living a life of dread—there is nothing farther than the truth. Loving and worshipping our Lord and our God is a beautiful experience—because our Lord and our God are real! What the Holy Word teaches about God the Father and Son are true. God is a loving Father who looks after His own (John 3:16).

Matthew 7:13 \sim ¹³ Enter by the narrow gate; for wide *is* the gate and broad *is* the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. ¹⁴ Because narrow *is* the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

The Joy of the Lord Is Strength and Peace

There is great joy in knowing that when we place God first, we have access to blessings that the world cannot take away from us. We have peace in the time of storm. We have a purpose in life that enhances our lives and the lives of those who receive through us the gospel. I am a witness to how, in spite of all the harshness of life, God continues to bless with unmeasurable peace and favor. To share, it is disheartening to see how many do not believe; it is even sadder to see how some are even angry at God. And if this was not enough, it is heartbreaking to see and know how those who walk with ministerial titles made or make a mockery out of the gospel by how they preyed upon the innocent and weak in spirit. That is why we should all that much more not shut God out of our lives. God warned us through His Holy Word that trials and tribulations will come, and that there will be wolves among the sheep (Matthew 10:16), but because of Jesus and His obedience to His Father,

we have the gift of everlasting life. We have the blessed assurance that this world is not our final resting place. Being within the Will of God is far more gratifying than being anywhere else in this world, and to add to this immeasurable blessing, our heavenly Father bestowed upon us through His Son Jesus, the power of The Holy Spirit as our Comforter and Guide.

It is a shame that there are those who share the gospel, but who also walk a contrary life. It is even a greater shame that those outside of God's Will looking in are discouraged by this fact. It is one thing to fall short; no one is without sin—repentance should and must follow (1 John 1:9)—but if one lives a deliberate life of sin and expect it to be fine with God, such a walk is on precarious ground.

On another note, one would be surprised to know or learn who in their midst are knowledgeable about the Will and Word of God—and may be even gifted in the spirit of prophesy; however, will not profess Jesus openly, lest their peers frown upon them. These are those who have allowed the cares of this world to choke the Word of God from their hearts, believing that to reveal their faith in Christ means to lose what they want, what they need, and what they consider as more valuable in life (Mark 4:19). Perhaps, this is what God would want them to be, under the radar Christians? Uhmm...what do you think? What I know is that I know too much about God to keep Him to myself. I am in my Room. I praise God in my Room. Then there are those who think, Why become saved? Look at what she is going through.... Or, for those who are favored, but are backsliding...look at what and are doing! Aren't they God-fearing people? They're not doing better than I! Why should I receive or believe anything they share with me pertaining to the Word of God? (O.K., I thought to change it up a bit with a couple of visual effects.) Those who are fighting the good fight of faith—keep on fighting! Those who profess to know Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior, but are not walking upright—abandon your ways that are contrary to His Will and repent—you're damaging your testimony in the sight of others. As Believers, we know that God is merciful and kind, He will pardon those who come to Him with a sincere heart and a transformed mind (Ephesians 1:7).

Romans 8:23 ~ ²⁸ And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose.

1 Peter 5:8 ~ 8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

Don't Criticize or Turn Away From The Gospel

When a person does not know God, or understand His Will, he or she not speculate but should study the Word of God for him- or herself, a workman who need not be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth (2 Timothy 2:15). That is also why one should remember, as expressed above, that many are called, but few are chosen (Matthew 22:14). So, if you, being an unbeliever, had read the Word of God, and then were blessed to have your eyes become spiritually opened, you will then understand that this world we live in is not our own (John 15:18-25). You will or should have opened eyes to understand and receive that many who end up denying God will one day cry, Lord! Lord! but will not make it in. You may also realize as a Believer that there will be experiences in life that will set you apart from those who you thought would be your partner, or close friend, for life. This may be a painful experience, too; however, I have learned that sometimes it is for the good for spiritual growth. The most important takeaway is that whatever comes our way, God will grant us peace beyond measure if we desire to receive Him at His Word, and that Jesus saves—for without Him in our lives, there is no remission of sins (Matthew 26:28).

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, Jesus' disciples were touched by The Holy Spirit to remember His teachings; having contained God's message to the world in the form of a collection of books that were written over 2,000 years ago collectively named The Holy Bible. So, how can we

ever doubt or denounce a collection of books that were written over 2,000 years ago that pretty much shouts relevance today? To turn away from God's teachings and path is to reject The Living God. To reject The Living God is spiritual suicide.

Knock and the Door Shall Open

I would like to share now that I was not finished with expounding upon the word: *Threshold*. When one is standing at a threshold, one is standing at a border (usually a wooden plank) that signifies the separation of an area of space. A threshold confirms the division of two rooms. So, if one is standing at a threshold, it means that one is standing at a place where there is an entrance to another specifically defined room. Have you ever entered a dwelling place where there was a wooden plank on the floor, and then a thought such as: 'This must be the dining area' or 'This must be where the living room ends.' If one is standing at a threshold, the border between one area of space and another, it also means that he or she has not yet entered into the other room, but is on the border line or near to it. Have you ever explored a building, or a place where you approached the threshold of another room, but for some reason, dare not go in—and not for any obvious or apparent reason?—i.e., no warning or signs prohibiting to do so. On the other hand, have you ever approached an unfamiliar threshold, but felt confident that you were meant to go forward? Do you ever remember coming to a new threshold, where there was also a door that was closed in order to get to the other side? This analogy is to stir up your consciousness that if you have not fully entered into the presence and place of God, you will not know Him for yourself because you were afar off from Him. Also, if you are fearful of knowing God, do not be. What you should fear is not knowing Him and losing your own soul.

Acts 26:28-29 ~ ²⁸ Then Agrippa said to Paul, *You almost persuade me to become a Christian.* ²⁹ And Paul said, I would to God that not only you, but also all who hear me today, might become both almost and altogether such as I am, except for these chains.

Enter The New Room

In visiting again the theme for this month, Standing in the doorway at the threshold into the New Room, means to me the place of transformation. It is a place where newness begins. The New Room is the place where we meet Jesus for ourselves. The New Room is a place in our own heart.

To have biblical truths come your way and you still not desire to enter into God's presence, or to not enjoy the blessings of *The New Room* is to stand at the threshold of salvation, but not receive it. To not enter into *The New Room* is to deny who Jesus is, or not believe that Jesus The Christ is King of Kings and Lord of Lords. To not take part of what *The New Room* offers is to succumb to all the sinfulness that plagues this world. To succumb to this world is to take the stand that it is preferable to lose one's soul because to follow Christ Jesus equates to missing out on the *quote* finer *close quote* things in life (James 1:20-22).

As Believers, we know the importance of seeking the presence of the Holy Spirit which is calming, comforting, and peaceful. Supported by the Word of God, fellowship, fasting, praying, and singing scriptures, we are encouraged and uplifted. We have the blessed assurance that we are heaven-bound—one day to become free from this world of sin (John 14:27) upon Jesus' return (1 Corinthians 15:52-54). So when trouble comes our way, we do not handle it like those in the world who act as though they have no hope. So, if you do not know Jesus The Christ for yourself, if you have not yet trusted in The Living God and His Word, the written word which has been documented over 2,000 years ago in various languages for various cultures, ask yourself, *Why not? I bet you do not have a good reason.* So, if you are at the threshold of *The New Room* where Jesus is knocking,

where Jesus is calling to you, go to Him—or let Him into your heart—while the blood is still running warm in your veins.

In closing, I would like to further expound upon this month's theme. *Did you know that the word 'threshold' also means a place or a point of a new beginning? Now, guess what?* Since you are reading this article, or if you have previously read inspirational writings, or if you have already read The Holy Bible, Jesus has already knocked in order to get your attention and is waiting for you to embrace *your new beginnings, your New Room—the New Room of your heart.* So, if you have not already done so, make space for Jesus The Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit in your life. Listen to His voice and the unction of The Holy Spirit. Embrace our Lord and God while you still have time.

Luke 13:25 ~ ²⁵ When once the Master of the house has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from....'

Revelation 3:20 ~ ²⁰ Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.

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Who Will Stand Between the Dead and the Living?

Like many, my heart is saddened to say the least, concerning the current events of today. As I prayed, I heard the Lord say, "Sons of Korah" and so I searched the scriptures for the answer to the Lord's instruction and He directed me to the 16th chapter of Numbers.

It was amazing to me how quickly the Lord "heard my humble cry."

In short, the story within the 16th chapter of Numbers tells of Korah who had an important responsibility within the tabernacle, (the church) but he wasn't satisfied with that. He wanted to be a priest and challenged God's appointed priests, Moses and Aaron and their priestly positions, thus he challenged God. Korah's sin is that he rebelled against God's authority to appoint as leaders' men of His own choosing. Korah also influenced many others to go along with him in his revolt and God destroyed them all but by this time the congregation of Israel accused Moses and Aaron of having killed "the people of the Lord." And as a consequence, God slew 14,700 people with a sudden plague. People began to die!

It's dangerous to agree or to "go along with the crowd" and to go against what God desires and whom He has chosen as His priests or those He called to do His will. This rule especially applies to the people of God. Korah and those who followed him were people of God and Korah influenced the people to talk against Moses and Aaron. Although Korah and some of his followers were destroyed the remnant of the congregation, began to say "Ye have killed the people of the Lord." This provoked the Lord to anger and a plague of death began to strike the people!

We cannot call good evil nor can we call evil good! There is a great temptation today to go along with the popularity rather than the word of God. What God has called sin is sin. What He has called an abomination is an abomination. Whom He has chosen, He has chosen for His specific purpose(s).
