

The Unwavering Relevance of God and His Word

It is easy to recognize that as we evolve through time that laws, fashion, styles, music, and people change. In examining laws more carefully, former President John F. Kennedy passed the Affirmative Action (AA) legislation in 1961. This legislation compelled government contractors to take action in moving forward toward the goal of national "nondiscrimination." The AA order recognized that systemic racism permeated society, particularly in academic institutions. Before the law was passed, people of color could not attend colleges and universities deemed as "white." They were relegated to poorly funded and less prestigious historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs). Without question, this type of racism stood to impact the generational well-being of people of color. The AA order opened new doors of opportunities that eroded the barriers of racism in academic settings and later in workplace settings after President Lyndon Johnson signed an Executive Order in 1965 prohibiting employment discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, and national origin.

However, in June 2023 the United States Supreme Court ended the Affirmative Action rule in colleges and universities. As a result, this has sparked conversations surrounding whether to continue affirmative action in the workplace. Diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) efforts have proved favorable in "leveling the playing field" (in workplace settings) when it comes to fostering equal opportunity for everyone to thrive and be successful. Those who oppose DEI practices in the workplace are likely supporters of the Supreme Court's decision. There have been other laws of the land passed including LGBTQ rights that have rapidly and profusely saturated the culture and practices of our world. Why am I pointing all of this out? It is a clear illustration of how through the evolution of time, people, laws, and ideas change. Notwithstanding this illustration, God nor His word never change. One of my favorite scriptures

in the Bible that underlines this truth is found in Hebrews 13:8 where it declares "Jesus Christ the same, yesterday, and today, and forever." The immutable or unchangeable nature of God and His Son Jesus Christ is demonstrated throughout scripture. Therefore, what God declares as holy, righteous, and true cannot be changed or disputed. His ways are inerrant and His Word is infallible. [8] whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts.





Gone are the days when the food we ate, we planted, picked, and cooked ourselves. As a child in the 60s, I remembered the fascination of drinking Tang "orange drink". It what the astronauts drink. Was the tag line, I believe. The operative word was and is today "orange" drink.

Today, you can find plenty of food items in the markets listed in this fashion. This way, they can't say it's really the actual food substance and directly, mislead the public. However, once you read the labels, you soon find that what you are eating in many cases, we created in a lab and mass produced, and contain no real food products at all.

It has been masked to give you the impression it's real food. You also have instances where certain foods have so much sugar, salt, or other chemicals in them. That you are driven to consume more of it. So, what can we do to be use we are eating healthy of selections of foods?

Read all food labels carefully. Get familiar with these banned ingredients and their alternative names, and look for them on packaged foods.

Eat minimally processed or, even better, whole, organic foods as much as possible. Fruits, vegetables, legumes, and grains won't have the long list of ingredients that packaged and processed foods often do.

Cook at home as much as you can. This way, you have more control over the food you're eating. You know exactly what ingredients are being used, and can decide to eat foods that best align with your values as much as possible.
