Players Code of Conduct

I hereby pledge to be positive when participating in youth sports by following this Players Code of Conduct.

- I will work hard to improve my skills by attending regularly scheduled practices and will encourage and assist my teammates to do the same.
- I will display good sportsmanship ahead of my own personal desire to win and will not partake in abusive or violent talk or behavior.
- I will shake hands with the other team at the end of all games and remember that games are played for fun!
- I will play by the rules established by the league and be respectful of the umpire or referee's judgment.
- I will show respect to all game officials, coaches, players, and spectators and never act in a manner that would be disrespectful toward them. I understand that I could be ejected from the game by an umpire/referee, coach or Parks and Rec representative for this type of behavior.
- I will be respectful of the parks and facilities by not littering or damaging property or equipment and understand that if I intentionally abuse any piece of equipment or facility that I will be subject to a warning and possible ejection from the game at the discretion of the umpire/referee and/or coach.
- I will always wear the proper uniform in the proper way.
- I realize that any subsequent offense or acts of unsportsmanlike conduct may result in ejection from a game at the discretion of the umpire, coach or Parks and Recreation representative.
- I will not participate in the use of tobacco, drug or alcohol products or demonstrate or promote acts of violence. I understand that doing so will result in suspension of a game a possible expulsion from the program.

Parents Code of Conduct Pledge

I hereby pledge to provide positive support and encouragement for my child's participation in youth sports by following this Parents Code of Conduct.

- I will be a positive role model and encourage good sportsmanship for my child by demonstrating positive support and respect for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game and practice.
- I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or of others.
- I will provide a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.

- I realize that the coaches and league organizers are volunteers and are donating their time and efforts for the enjoyment of the youth and I will promise to respect their decisions.

Grafton Parks and Recreation Disclaimer

I agree for myself and child (or legal dependent) whose name appears above as registered for participation in the event or program described in this document. In consideration of the acceptance of this registration and the participation of myself and any minor whose name appears above, I hereby, on my behalf and their behalf, release the Grafton Park District, its agents and employees from all claims for injuries or property damage that I or they may sustain arising out of the event. I and any such minor recognize and acknowledge that there are risks of physical injury to participants in the event both known and unknown and I agree for myself and on their behalf to assume the risks of such injuries, damages, or loss which I or they may sustain as a result of participation in said event. I release the Grafton Park District and its agents and employees from any such claims and I agree to indemnify and hold the Grafton Park District, its agents and employees harmless from any claims by any of the minors listed below arising out of or in any way related to the event.
