

# Plants for Cape Ann Gardens

(Tolerant of Seashore Conditions)

Whether you are an 8 or an 18; a 32A or a 36D; a 6N or a 9W; 48 or 84; . . . you are definitely a 6b!!!!!

6b is the USDA Plant Hardiness Zone for Rockport. The USDA Plant Hardiness Zone Map is the standard by which gardeners and growers can determine which plants are most likely to thrive at a location. The map is based on the average annual minimum winter temperature. Rockport's is between -5° and 0° so we are in Zone 6b. This is useful information if you are purchasing exotic plants or want to bring a prized plant home from another part of the state or the country.

We are certainly fortunate to live and to garden on Cape Ann. The main challenges we face as coastal gardeners are wind and salt air. Although nurseries and garden centers in our area generally offer plants we can grow in Rockport, you may want to focus on the following plants if you deal with wind and salty air. You also will want to water your plants (leaves too!) after a heavy storm to remove the salt. The following is a list of plants that will withstand seashore conditions better than most. For the sake of space, common names are usually given.
