- Facilities are for members and their personal guests only, each person at their own risk.
- Pay fees for guests in the lock box at the pool gate or along with reservations.
 - Parents, grandparents, children, and grandchildren of members are free.
 - Siblings, aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, and friends are all paid guests.
 - Guest children under 5 are free.
- Facility privileges are revoked for those delinquent in their dues (per bylaws section 2, c).
- Children under 10 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times in all areas.
- Persons under 18 must be supervised by an adult member unless lifeguards present.
- Belwood members are responsible for and must accompany their guests.
- Guests are allowed in pool area only when lifeguards on duty.
- Lifeguards may be hired for extended duty hours.
- Members should be prepared to identify themselves to others.
- Keys for access available with reservations or by paying pool key fee.
- Each household using pool key must pay the associated fee no loaning/sharing of keys.
- Users of the facility must clean up after themselves.
 - No smoking anywhere in the facility.
 - No pets allowed on cabana property (except service dogs).
- No use of bicycles, skates, skateboards, scooters inside facility and the parking lot.
 - No climbing or standing on BBQ pits, furniture, poles, fences, or trees.
 - No loitering or playing in restrooms or behind buildings.
 - No weapons or dangerous objects.
 - Parking lot is for members and their guests while using facility only. No overnight parking.
 - No loud noise after 10pm and before 8am (per Los Gatos Town Code sec 16.20.010).
 - Lifeguards, managers, and board members have full authorigy over all facilities, and to suspend privileges for improper behavior or violating facility rules.

Pool

- Use pool at your own risk. Never swim alone.
 - Members must sign in at pool gate.
- Lifeguards are normally present 1pm-7pm mid-June through Labor Day weekend.
- Do not disturb the on-duty lifeguards, their attention must be undivided.
 - All persons entering the pool area must obey instructions of lifeguards.
 - Children in the kiddie pool must be closely supervised by an adult within the pool area.
 - · Kiddie pool is not guarded by lifeguards.
 - Swimmers in large pool are subject to swimming proficiency test (swim pool length).
 - Non-swimming and inexperienced swimmers must be accompanied by a parent or guardian designated by the parent while in the pool unless he or she:
 - is wearing a U.S. Coast Guard approved life vest;
 - AND is restricted to the shallow end of the pool;
 - AND is tall enough to have his/her chin clear the top of the water while standing;

- 48 AND can demonstrate the ability to maneuver in the life vest. 49
 - Otherwise, the parent or guardian must be in the pool with that child.
- 50 Children under 10 years must be supervised by an adult within the pool area at all times.
 - A life vest may be worn by a child only if he/she is accompanied by an adult in the pool.
 - No water wings or other non-U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices allowed.
 - Only children under 7 years of age are allowed in the kiddie pool.
 - Vinyl or latex swim pants are required for swimmers not toilet trained or under 4.
 - "Swim diapers" are not an acceptable substitute.
 - Adult swim (without lifeguards) is last 15 minutes of each hour.
 - One child may accompany each adult (within arm's length) during this time.
 - Large pool parties will be required to hire additional lifequards, even during regular hours.
 - Adults have right to request a lap lane rope be installed by the lifeguard.
 - Long hair must be tied, braided, or capped when in pool.
 - All swimmers must wear swimsuits (cutoffs must be hemmed).
 - No Diving. No running on pool deck. No horseplay in or around the pool area. •
 - No diving at shallow end of pool. No flips or splash dives off side of pool.
 - No large play equipment.
 - No hanging on ropes or lane lines.
 - No alcohol allowed within the pool area.
 - No glass allowed within the pool area.
 - No food and no gum allowed within the pool area.
 - Lifeguards may issue warnings for inappropriate, discourteous, or dangerous behavior.
 - Pool user will be banned for the rest of the day after 3 warnings on that day.
 - Pool user will be banned for rest of season if banned for more than 4 days.
 - When Lifequards not present:
 - Only members having paid pool key fee for current year allowed 6am 10pm.
 - No swimming if the pool is posted as closed (only due to health safety).
 - No swimming alone. Another member must be present.
 - No guests when lifequards are not present (note that you may hire guards).
 - Persons under 18 must have responsible adult member within the pool area.
 - The pool gates are to be kept closed (so other children don't wander in).
 - Swim team will provide a lane during practices, unless a safety issue exists.

Cabana Building Renters 80

- Reduce noise after 10 PM (per Los Gatos Town Code sec 16.20.010).
 - Guest fees for cabana included in rental, but normal guest fees required for pool use.
- 83 Rental of Cabana building provides exclusive use of the Cabana kitchen and rec-room.
 - Other members may enjoy using the outdoor facilities at the same time.
 - When renting the Cabana, include the time needed for set-up and clean-up.
 - Use only blue painter's masking tape on walls. (It leaves no residue).
 - Eye hooks near ceiling are for hanging decorations. Don't add more.
 - Do not use: staples, nails, scotch tape, duct tape, package tape, etc.
 - The deposit collected with all reservations may be retained to correct damages.

BBQ Areas

- BBQ pits and tables available on first-come basis unless reserved in advance.
- 93 Reservations are posted in the lifeguard office.
 - Guest fees apply for all non-members in your party.

Cleanup

- 97 Cabana Renters:
 - Remove decorations.
 - Sweep the cabana rooms.
 - Clear refrigerator (except for items marked by lifeguards).
- Anything left in refrigerator may be discarded at any time.
- Wipe the counter and sink.
- Remove trash from cans to the dumpster and reline cans.
- Turn off interior lights.
- Close windows.
- Lock all doors.

- Do not put coals into lined trash cans.
 - Put old, cold coals into smaller unlined ash-can.
- 110 Both:
- Clear grounds of wrappers and other litter.
 - Remove trash from cans to the dumpster and reline trash cans.
- Please use recycling bins as much as possible.
- Restrooms: Sweep, close windows, turn off lights, and lock doors unless others present.
- Close and latch front gate, unless other members present.

When Others Enter Facility

- If you have opened the gate outside of the regular open hours (e.g., for a meeting or party) you may feel responsibility for others who have entered the facility as it is our common property.
- However, it is not your responsibility to take police action.

 When leaving, you might gently inquire of others you
 - When leaving, you might gently inquire of others whether they are members and have a key. Do not do this if you are uncomfortable about it.
 - If they don't have a key and don't promptly leave, do not insist they leave or threaten to call police. You should not risk increasing any tension. Just leave and close the gate.
 - It is suggested you not leave children in the pool area without an adult present. If they refuse to leave, call parents, a board director, or the police and wait for them to arrive.
 - Communicate the situation to the facility manager leave a message on the Cabana phone (358-2229) describing who is there and the date and time.
 - If the people are obviously causing damage or misusing the facility, then call the police once you are safely away from the facility.
