Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walkthrough is restricted to handlers entered in that class. Walkthroughs will be held prior to the Novice, Open, and Excellent/Masters classes. A warm-up jump will be provided.

Entry Fees

each includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee \$25-first entry, each dog, each day \$15-2nd/3rd/4th/5/6th entries, each dog, same day

Awards Titling Classes: A green ribbon will be awarded to

all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Ribbons will be awarded to qualifying dogs placing 1st - 4th and to those completing MX/MXJ/MXP/MJP/PAX titles. A special MACH/PACH/AGCH rosette & MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to teams completing a MACH/PACH/ AGCH title. All awards must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed. Exhibitors will receive one entry gift for each dog entered for the weekend.

Exhibitor Clothing

Club or AKC event clothing may be worn by anyone. Clothing may display the person's name, dog's call name &/or the dog's picture, but no titles. Writing or graphics must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. Clothing must not display any info that would be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial.

Food and drinks will be available for purchase at the on-site restaurant forbreakfast & lunch

Crating Space - the trial site requires a waterproof tarp or at to be placed underneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, neither TRSSCGP nor B&D will be responsible for loss or damage of items left at the show site. X-pens allowed for VERY large or multiple dogs only.

Thursday Setup is from 1:00 PM. Vouchers for a free run in the 2024 agility trial will be provided for those helping for the entire set up. Helping hands are welcome!!

Overnight RV parking & camping at the show site is permitted; see form on p4.

Please clean up after your dogs! Exhibitors failing to clean up after their dog(s) may be excused without refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning and pick-up supplies and disposal sites will be available at several locations on the show grounds.

Directions to B&D Creekside (501 Avenue B, Latrobe, PA 15650):

From US-30 or further South: head towards Latrobe; take PA-982 North for 1 mile from US-30. Turn left onto Ligonier St, go 0.3 miles. Turn left onto Avenue B, drive 0.4 miles to reach B&D. From US-22 or further North: head towards New Alexandria: take PA-981 South for 6.5 miles



Notice to Exhibitors

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **Puppies** under 4 months of age are prohibited from the show grounds. **All dogs must be on leash** or confined except when being judged or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Express delivery entries must include a signature permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address without the recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to sender. ***Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on an official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with <u>signed Agreement</u> and Instructions attached cannot be accepted.***

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. Confirmation of acceptance will be made if either an email address or a self-addressed, stamped postcard with checkboxes for each class entered is included with the entry.

Owners are responsible for **errors made while filling out entry forms,** whoever makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully to minimize errors! Every effort will be made to find all **duplicate entries**; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Make all checks and money orders **payable to TRSSCGP** in US funds only. Please mail fees with entries. The Trial Secretary and TRSSCGP assume no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Postdated or returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a **\$20 service charge** for returned checks.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. No fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed in the event of riots, civil disturbances, fire, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees less \$5/run for bitches in season will be refunded. Refunds of fees less \$5/run will be issued for dogs unable to compete due to other medical conditions if veterinary certification is presented before the end of the trial weekend. Full refunds will be issued for deceased dogs if the Trial Secretary is notified prior to the start of the trial. Due to the cost of processing refunds, overpayment of less than \$5 per dog per day will be donated to Sheltie Rescue.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. Handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when it is their turn to run. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

The TRSSCGP and its agents assume **no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury** sustained by exhibitors, handlers, their dogs or property, or their children.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive, or blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

AVMA Health Statement

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

Obstacles

All obstacles will conform to requirements as specified in the current revision of the "Regulations for Agility Trials" from the American Kennel Club (available at www.akc.org).

For Exhibition Only (FEO) & Fix and GoOn (FnG)

- For Exhibition Only (FEO) will allow exhibitors to work with dogs in a trial environment, in the T2B & FAST classes only. FEO runs are trial entries - must enter in advance in the desired jump height
- Fix and GoOn—allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation.

Height Divisions & Mixed Height/Mixed Class Entries

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All heights are as measured at the withers. Dogs measuring into the 8 thru 20" Regular divisions may optionally enter the 24C division .

Regular Class (*Preferred Class*) jump height divisions:

8 <i>(4)</i> inchesfor dogs	11 inches and under
12/8/inchesfor dogs	14 inches and under
16/12/inchesfor dogs	18 inches and under

- 20/16/inches.. for dogs 22 inches and under
- 24*(20)* inches.. for dogs over 22 inches
- 24C division .. for dogs 22" and under at owner's discretion *(n/a Preferred)*

Dogs entered in **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in Regular classes as listed above.

- Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/ or during a trial weekend
- Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day
 - \Rightarrow Separate entry forms must be submitted for each jump height &/or division (Reg/Pref) entered

First Received Entries

Entries accepted no sooner than Tuesday, April 16th at 8am. No hand-delivered entries will be accepted during the first 24 hours. **Entries close** 4pm Wednesday, May 29th.

Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be treated as an invalid entry and will be returned. All First Received Entry rules and regulations as they appear in Chapter 1. Section 16 of the Regulations for Agility Trials shall apply.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
