Class Schedule and Registration

Puppy Class from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Mondays starting 5/6/24

Puppy Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Mondays starting 5/6/24

Puppy Class from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Mondays starting 5/6/24

Prerequisites: Dogs need to be 10-weeks to 6-months old and must have current shots.

Description: The goal of the puppy class is to help you and your new puppy get to know each other and to introduce basic obedience concepts to the puppy. The class addresses many factors in having a well socialized puppy such as handling and confidence building activities, as well as training with other young dogs. Training is done in a class setting where concepts of attention, walking on a leash, reliable recalls, impulse control, waits, and stays are introduced. The *AKC Star Puppy* test is available at the end of this class.

Cost of class is \$115 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$105 IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.

Puppy Plus / Manners from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Mondays starting 5/6/24 FULL

Puppy Plus / Manners from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Mondays starting 5/6/24

Puppy Plus / Manners from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Tuesdays starting 5/7/24 FULL

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills. For small-breed dogs up to 18-months old, and large-breeds up to 12-months old with Instructor's approval.

Description: This class is designed for further socialization of young dogs. Basic skills of heeling, recalls, sits, downs, and stays will be reinforced. Training of manners for having a well-rounded family pet will be a focus of this class. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your young dog. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.**

Foundations of Obedience I Class from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Tuesdays starting 5/7/24

Foundations of Obedience I Class from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Wednesdays starting 5/8/24

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills.

Description: This class will teach the foundation skills for having a well-rounded family pet, and for competitive obedience. Attention, heeling, sits and downs, sit/wait with attention, recall games, and stays will be covered. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your dog. This class is also useful as a basis for dogs/handler planning on agility. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks!**

Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.

Foundations of Obedience II Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Thursdays starting 5/9/24

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills.

Description: Behaviors such as stay, coming when called, walking on-leash & off-leash, are practiced with distractions using creative, fun games and exercises. Teaching your dog to focus on you when the environment gets busy is essential to a happy life with your dog. This class provides excellent preparation for trainers interested in dog sports: agility, competition obedience, and rally obedience. The *AKC Canine Good Citizen* test will be available after this class. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.**

Foundations of Obedience III Class from 6:15- 7:15 pm, Tuesdays starting 5/7/24

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II or have equivalent skills.

Description: The curriculum for this class will be fluid, and based on student needs. A fun class for you and your dog while reviewing and proofing obedience skills, enhancing confidence skills, and beginning a transition to off-leash work. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100 IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.**

Advanced Obedience / Rally from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Thursdays starting 5/9/24

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills.

Description: Traditional Rally class for those wanting to compete, and earn a Rally title. *All levels of rally signs will be incorporated to meet individual needs of handlers.* **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.**

AKC Fit Dog Silver (Level 2) Class from 7:30 -8:30 pm, Thursdays starting 5/9/24

Prerequisites: Dogs need have completed Level One before enrolling in Level Two.

Description: The AKC FIT DOG program is a program developed by the American Kennel Club and taught by our AKC FIT DOG Instructor, Pat Kelm. Classes are designed to be fun and fitness-focused, with the goal of getting your dog into better shape. All activities are based upon positive reinforcement methods. You will learn proper form and safety while doing various fitness exercises involving balance, flexibility, stamina, and overall body fitness, which can help prevent future injuries. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.**

Speedway and Rodeo Dog Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Mondays starting 5/6/24

Speedway and Rodeo Dog Class from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Wednesdays starting 5/8/24

Speedway and Rodeo Dog Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Wednesdays starting 5/8/24 FULL

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills.

Description: Speedway and Rodeo Dog results in a well-rounded and conditioned dog. The dog enjoys moving around barrels, and through hoops and tunnels. The handler finds challenges deciding the best way to manage the dog through courses. Good teamwork can develop with any dog and handler team. Speedway and Rodeo Dog improves handling skills that can be incorporated for agility use. Instructor is Michelle Yackovich.

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I, and an Intermediate Scent Work Class or have instructor’s approval.

Description: Teamwork, and identifying your dog’s signals, will be the focus of this class. Multiple scents, containers, and interior & exterior hides will be explored in this class, including vehicle and buried hides. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.**

Dog Olympics Tricks Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Tuesdays starting 5/7/24

Dog Olympics Tricks Class from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Tuesdays starting 5/7/24 FULL

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I class, or have equivalent skills.

Description: Build your dog’s confidence, work toward *Do More With Your Dog* specialty trick titles, and have fun with your dog. Featuring balls, hoops, beams, and fetch tricks. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by 4/23/24.**
