"Jessica Miller, CPDT-KA, CNWI, PMCT -

Jessica began working professionally with dogs in 2011 and opened her training company, Go Pawsitive, in 2013. She has competed with 4 dogs in NACSW, reaching the Elite level with her Australian Shepherd Penny. In 2014, Jessica was certified as a Canine Nose Work Instructor (CNWI) through NACSW and has been teaching clients using the K9 Nose Work® method since 2012. She has coached teams working from Novice level through Summit and Detective. Currently, she has clients competing successfully in NACSW, AKC, CWAGS, CPE, and PSD.

In 2017 Jessica became the first person in Maryland to be licensed as an AKC Scent Work judge, licensed to judge all levels from Novice-Detective. In 2022 she completed the NACSW Certifying Official Program and is currently a CO for trials and ORTs.

One of the cornerstones of Jessica's teaching is the handler learning to be a curious student of the dog's behavior. She emphasizes a strong knowledge of canine olfaction and the dynamics of odor movement to evaluate the scent picture. In addition, she teaches repeatable handling skills, adding leash handling, start-line preparation and footwork early on to promote cohesive teamwork from the start."
