A HOW-TO GUIDE to Prepare Yard Waste for Curbside Collection



**CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION IS AS** 

## EASYAS 1, 2, 3

**1. BAG, BUNDLE or CONTAINERIZE.** Leaves, grass clippings, twigs and small pieces of yard waste. Containerized yard waste should **NOT exceed 32-gallons** in size and **50 pounds** in weight.







2. STACK NEATLY PARALLEL TO THE CURB. Palm fronds, branches, shrubs, and stumps. Items should NOT exceed6 feet in length and 50 pounds in weight.







**3. SEPARATE.** Garbage, recycling and yard waste must be separated by resident and placed **curbside by 6 a.m.** on the scheduled collection day.

## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

- **Do not** blow leaves and yard waste into the street and storm drains that empty into nearby waterways.
- Yard waste placed in front of a vacant lot, land, or property will not be collected.
- Items that are **not considered as yard waste** include: Whole trees, land clearing debris, fencing, landscape timbers, garden hoses, planters, flowerpots, and yard decorations.
