

Design Pavilion provides a platform for leading international designers, architects and artists to create and build innovative structures of inspiration, shared in-person and virtually.


A show of sustainable structures in outdoor venues, placed at landmark locations and neighborhoods, offering a variety of communities the opportunity to engage.






