We, the undersigned, hereby make application to Hardin County for permission to apply dust suppression in the described location. The Applicant agrees to the following:

1. **DEADLINE FOR SIGN-UP IS APRIL 27th.**
2. **Applications received after that date will be assessed a late fee of \$25.00.**
3. To maintain flags identifying the outer limits of the area to be treated for dust suppression. **Flags must be in place by April 27th and kept visible until mid-October.** Using the four county furnished flags will serve to visually remind the blade operator as to the location of the treated area. Failure to identify the treated area may result in your dust suppression being bladed through. Neither the county nor Jerico Services, Inc. assumes any liability if your flags are not in place. If your spot is not marked when we come to apply your dust suppression we will center your application on your home.
4. The county reserves the right to blade the treated area if it is deemed necessary for public safety. In the event of rain, the county also reserves the right to do light blading on treated areas for public safety. **Your road will be thoroughly bladed after mid-October in preparation for winter.** The owner shall maintain the treated area and repair any roughness that may develop.
5. Used motor oil is not allowed per the EPA.
6. Jerico Services, Inc. does not guarantee the performance of the product due to factors such as weather, surface preparation or heavy traffic patterns. This permit is for **two** applications only.

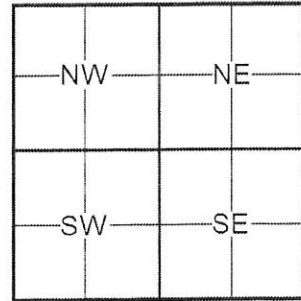

CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

The application and maintenance of chemicals to control dust on crushed rock surfaced roads shall be by permit only and in accordance with the following conditions:

1. Road chemicals may be applied by the owner or an approved contractor for owner.
2. The only materials approved for use on the roads are calcium chloride, magnesium chloride, and lignin sulfonate. Used motor oil is not allowed per EPA.
3. The owner shall maintain the treated area and repair any roughness that may develop.
4. The County reserves the right to rework the treated areas and maintain them as loose granular surfaces, without notice to the owner, if the owner fails to maintain the area in a condition acceptable to the County, and at no cost to the County.
5. On or about mid-October dust control locations will be bladed through in preparation for winter weather.
