We, the undersigned, hereby make application to Tama County for permission to apply **two applications** of dust suppression in the described location. The Applicant agrees to the following:

- 1. DEADLINE FOR SIGN-UP IS APRIL 6th. No applications can be accepted after this date for the 1st application.
- 2. To maintain Jerico Services, Inc. flags identifying the outer limits of the area to be treated with Calcium Chloride. FLAGS MUST BE IN PLACE BY APRIL 16TH AND KEPT VISIBLE UNTIL OCTOBER 1^{ST.} Failure to identify the treated area with Jerico flags may result in your dust suppression being bladed through. Neither the county nor Jerico Services, Inc. assumes any liability if your flags are not in place. If your flags are not in place we will center the application on your house. Your spot will be thoroughly bladed after October 1st in preparation for winter.
- 3. If, in Tama County's opinion, sufficient surface deterioration has developed on a treated area as to become a liability to the traveling public, or if the road conditions dictate that maintenance is required, the road department will perform the necessary maintenance. Tama County at no time will be responsible for the cost of re-treatment of the affected area. The county will blade all dust suppression spots in preparation for the second application regardless of when the first application was completed.
- 4. **LIQUIDOW**[™] **Calcium Chloride** is a very effective dust suppression product; however Jerico Services, Inc. does not guarantee the performance of the product due to factors such as weather, surface preparation or heavy traffic patterns.
