- 1. **DEADLINE FOR SIGN-UP IS MAY 2nd.** In order for the county to have sufficient time to prepare the roads before the first application, **no applications can be accepted after this date.**
- 2. To maintain Jerico Services, Inc. flags identifying the outer limits of the area to be treated. Flags must be in place by May 7th and kept visible until October 1st. Using Jerico Services, Inc. flags will serve to visually remind the blade operator as to the location of the treated area. Failure to identify the treated area may result in your dust suppression being bladed through. Neither the county nor Jerico Services, Inc. assumes any liability if your flags are not in place. Your road will be thoroughly bladed after October 1st in preparation for winter.
- 3. The applicant is responsible for the maintenance of any potholes, washouts, secondary ditches, etc. which may develop in the treated area. The county reserves the right to blade the treated area if it is deemed necessary for public safety, and in the event of rain, the county also reserves the right to do light blading on the treated area. To blade with proper moisture does not detract from calcium chlorides' ability to suppress dust.
- 4. This agreement is limited to two treatments only.

WARREN COUNTY DUST CONTROL POLICY

WHEREAS, numerous requests are received by Warren County for the placement of dust control on various sections of local secondary roads, now;

BE IT RESOLVED on a motion by Crystal McIntyre, second by Dean Yordi, that the following policy be adopted for the placing of dust control material on the local secondary road system commencing in the 2016 calendar year:

- 1. Dust control material placed on any local secondary road shall be at the requesting party's expense.
- 2. No dust control material is to be applied on any local secondary road except by vendor(s) approved by the Warren County Engineer.
- 3. Information regarding the application of dust control material on any local secondary road shall be obtained from the vendor.
- 4. The type of dust control material to be used must be approved by the Warren County Engineer prior to its application on any local secondary road.
- 5. Any potholes, washouts, secondary ditches, etc., which may develop in the treated surface may result in Warren County scarifying and blading the surface without notice.
- 6. The requesting party shall be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs and flags designating the outer limits where the dust control material is placed. Failure to do so may result in Warren County blading the involved area, for which Warren County assumes no liability.
- 7. Warren County will not necessarily place rock on dust control locations.
- 8. Requesting parties applying for dust control must sign and date a form provided by the vendor acknowledging they have received a copy of this dust control policy. This side of permit (copy) shall be submitted by the vendor (Jerico Services, Inc.) to the Warren County Engineer prior to the placement of dust control materials.
- 9. Warren County reserves the right to perform any maintenance operations within the treated surface area and the adjacent right of way.
