Before your Trip:

- 1. You are crossing into Mexico, then back to the US. Please do not bring prohibited items on the day of your trip. This includes, but is not limited to: Marijuana, alcohol, firearms of any kind, agriculture, or valuables. Ensure that you have a current passport. For information on US Customs and Border Patrol, including current laws, follow this link: https://www.cbp.gov/travel/us-citizens/know-before-you-go/your-trip
- 2. Download WhatsApp from Google Playstore or iPhone App Store. This is non-negotiable. Most Providers in Mexico communicate this way. You will also receive lab results, images, reports, photos and appointment information this way.
- 3. Add MedVoyage to your contact list, if not already added. 619-714-0065
- 4. Add your Providers in Tijuana to your contacts.

FAQ:

Do I need pesos?

No, most people will not need pesos. Our Providers take US Cards. You can exchange currency should you choose to do so at the many "Casas de Cambio" next to the border parking. The pharmacies, shops, restaurants and misc. merchants all take US Dollars in Tijuana.

How safe is it to travel in Tijuana?

Tijuana is a large, metropolitan city. The risks of travel are similar to any large city. MedVoyage is fully insured on both sides of the border and does everything possible to ensure passenger safety. We do not recommend leaving the group to navigate the city alone if you are not familiar with the landscape.

Do I need to speak Spanish?

Tijuana is a border city. Many Providers are fluent in English. However, as an added service, MedVoyage provides language interpretation whenever needed.
