## **CLASSIC VEHICLE SCHEME (CVS) NEW APPLICANTS**

CMC is an approved organisation (AO) for CVS registrations, so please read below carefully

You should fill in sections 1 and 2 only (not section 3) of the Classic Vehicle Declaration (Transport NSW No. 1835).

This is for the CMC to fill in and sign as we are your approved organisation and the authorised person.

The primary club, i.e., your club, should simply stamp the lower right hand box to say you are a financial member Without that stamp, we will not process the application

Also required is the Club Check list for CMC which your club will sign and stamp to say they accept your vehicle

Please <u>do not</u> send us the original of the AUVIS or Unregistered Vehicle Inspection Report (blue slip). A photocopy is sufficient for our records.

This avoids the relatively expensive document going astray in the mail.

## All CMC need is:

- The Classic Vehicle Declaration (No. 1835) filled in as above
- A copy of the blue slip (do not send the original)
- A copy of the CMC CVS Check List (which your club signs and stamps after inspecting your vehicle)
- Your payment of the fee to CMC per below

The fee is \$25.00 for the processing, and, included in that is a domestic letter with tracking envelope for return to you. This then gives us a way to find documents should they go astray.

You can pay the \$25.00 fee by cheque or money order made payable to CMC CVS, or you can EFT the funds to CMC CVS

When you attend Service NSW, you must insist on them looking at the CLASSIC Vehicle Scheme (CVS). If they incorrectly look at the Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS), they will confuse matters.

Please <u>do not</u> accept plates with J on the end, as they are for Historic registration (HVS) which is for stock standard vehicles. Motorcycles will receive smaller plates with four numbers and a letter.

Once you have your plates, <u>please advise us and your club of the numbers and letter with your name</u>, as we must record these on our register. As we don't have access to Transport NSW records, we rely on you providing this information to us. Email them to:
