- I. Call to Order at 7:00 p.m.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor Martin
- III. <u>Roll Call:</u> Present were Commr Anderson, Calenda, Jones, Murphy, Niemann, Vice Mayor Carroll, Mayor Martin
- IV. <u>Approval of Funding for full-time police officer</u>: Chief Loos prior request to change a part-time officer designation to a full-time position in order to promote retention of employees and ease "manpower" issues.
 - **A. Motion:** by Commr Calenda to convert the part time officer position to fulltime within the confines of current budget.2nd by Commr Niemann.

Discussion: Led by Mayor after her reaching out to Mr. Whitley of the finance committee to better understand available funds while being fiscally sound

Roll Call Vote: Voting Yes were Commr Anderson, Calenda, Jones, Murphy, Niemann, Vice Mayor Carroll, and Mayor Martin.

Vote was 7 Yes, 0 No.

Motion Approved: Town/Police Department will convert the position and hire a fulltime officer approved by the Chief.

A2. Chief Loos hire authority: Prior meeting Chief Loos commented he is interviewing candidates and narrowed his selection. There was discussion of prior of cost to hire.

Motion: by Commr Calenda to hire an officer at \$16.50 an hour at Chiefs Loos discretion of candidate pending the passing of a background check. Commr Anderson 2nd

Discussion: The need to retain employees to cut cost balanced with background check.

Roll Call: Voting Yes were Commr. Anderson, Calenda, Jones, Murphy, Niemann, Vice Mayor Carroll, and Mayor Martin.

Vote was 7 yes, 0 No

Motion Approved: To hire new Officer "Julie M." pending the successful completion of a background investigation at \$16.50 an hour.

- V. <u>Approval of funding for annual raises:</u> Prior meeting issue of COVID and revenues occurred.
 - **A. Motion:** by Commr Niemann to provide a 1% raise to eligible employees with a .50 cent raise per hours to Deputy Clerk for exceptional service. Commr. Calenda 2nd

Roll Call: Voting Yes were Commr Anderson, Calenda, Jones, Murphy, Niemann, Vice Mayor Carroll, and Mayor Martin.

Vote was 7 Yes, 0 No.

Discussion: The need to balance Town operation cost while appreciating employees. Possible recommendations spoken of for the future to express value to employees via prebudget assessments and use of bonus.



Motion Approved: For across the board 1% raise of eligible employees with Deputy Clerk receiving a plus.50 cent raise per hour.
