- Post-Secondary acceptance
- Community involvement—in or out of school
- Strong cultural connection
- Kind, caring, and respectful in nature
- A leader

Requirements:

- 1 personal statement, written or recorded, by the applicant outlining how they meet the criteria
- At least 1 letter of support from someone who knows the applicant and can attest to their character and cultural connections
- Proof of Indigenous ancestry
- Post-secondary acceptance letter
