Walk-A-Thon... Thank you for sending your labels in. We surpassed our label goal and mailed out over 900 letters! Our fundraising goal is \$20,000. On Friday, May 10, students will walk at the school from 12pm-2pm. Snacks, water, and rest breaks will be provided. Students are permitted to wear jeans or dress code approved khaki shorts and a picture shirt of their choice. Hats and sunscreen are encouraged during the walk. Parents are permitted to join and walk with their students. Regular dismissal procedures will be in place.

Water Bottles... Please remember to send your child with a sealable water bottle every day. Filling stations are available. We have a few water bottles in the office for emergencies, but as it gets warmer, it is difficult to keep up with demand.

WPA Scholarship Info... The WPA K-12 Scholarship application is available. If you need any financial assistance, you must apply for this scholarship. Packets were sent home with the April calendar. If you need another packet, please contact the school, and we will send the scholarship packet home with your student. **The deadline to apply is 5/31/24.**

2024-2025 Book Fees... Book Fees are \$200 per student. This fee has been assessed to your FACTS account and is due on 5/31/24. You have the option to sign in to your account and make payments towards this bill when it is convenient for you, or if you wait, FACTS will withdraw the full amount. The remaining balance will be withdrawn by FACTS on 5/31/24. **(Payments should not be sent to the school.)** There is a \$25 late fee per student for all book fees paid after May 31.

Last Day of School... On Thursday, May 23rd, CACS will have an Awards Ceremony for Grades 1-11 at 10 a.m. Parents are welcome to attend in the C&MA Sanctuary and take their students home directly afterwards (regular dismissal procedures will be in place). Students should wear dress code approved clothing. If students aren't going home after the ceremony, they must bring a packed lunch. School will be dismissed at 12:00 p.m.

Accounts Past Due... CACS families must be up to date on their tuition and lunch accounts before final report cards and awards will be released to students.



Dress Code Reminders

Khaki Shorts.....Starting May 1st, students have the option to wear khaki shorts with their dress code polo shirts. Shorts may not have extra pockets (cargo style) or cuffs and must fall within 1" of the top of the knee.

Jeans.....Reminder on Jean's Day, jeans may be any color or pattern. Jeans may not be tight fitting and **may not** have any holes (even if there is fabric underneath) or visible fraying. No leggings.

Field Trip Dress Codes..For the End of the Year Field Trips, students are permitted to wear fingertip length shorts of any material. They may not be tight fitting, have holes (even if there is a patch underneath), or fraying. Students may wear picture shirts. Sleeveless shirts must be a minimum of 2" wide at the narrowest spot. No bare midriffs.

Onward and Upward...Remember that students are growing, and shorts, dresses, and skirts may not fit them the same way that they did in the fall. Shorts, dresses, and skirts must fall within 1" of the top of the knee even if leggings are worn underneath. Also, if your student has outgrown any dress code appropriate clothing that is still in good shape, please donate it to school for PTO's Dress Code Clothing Sale.
