

1st Grade E-Day Assignments

Choose <u>one</u> Reading, <u>one</u> Writing AND <u>one</u> Math Assignment. The pencil and paper assignments must be completed and turned in once they come back to school.

Draw a picture. Write 4 sentences about the picture. (Writing)

Spend 15 minutes reading a book at home. (Reading)

Write the book(s) down that your child read to you along with your signature

Write about what you did on your snow day. It must include sentences with details. The paper should have at least **5 to 10 sentences. Draw a picture that goes with your story.** (Writing)

Practice addition problems with 2 dice. (do 10 to 20 problems) (Math)

Write the problems down on paper and turn it in.

Practice even and odd numbers with skittles or m&m's (*or anything you can count*). Get 10 - 20 items, have the student group it into 2. Say a number, have the student put that many out. Have him/her tell you whether it's even or odd. Have him/her write the number down and write if the number is even or odd. (**Math**) Write out the numbers that you did and turn it in. **Do at least 15 practices.**

Example: 3 - odd 6 - even

Get a handful of coins from your change jar, separate into different piles of coins. Count with a parent. Ask questions like: how many ways can make

10 cents, 15 cents, 20 cents, 25 cents, etc. write down on paper what you did. (**Math**) **Do ten problems**

Example: 50 cents - 25, 25

72 cents - 25, 25, 10,10,1,1
