## § 65-1. Littering and dumping on public property.

It shall be and hereby is unlawful for any person or persons to permit to fall or to place upon any street, alley, sidewalk, gutter, sewer inlet, park, building or any other public property of the Borough of Curwensville any garbage, rubbish, refuse, waste, ashes, wastepaper, paper boxes, sweepings, limbs of trees or litter of any kind whatsoever, except for the immediate loading for the removal of the same.

### § 65-2. Distributing bills, posters and advertising material.

No person shall throw, place or distribute any dodgers, bills, posters or other advertising matter of any description, or any free samples of medicine or other articles, upon any public streets, lanes, alleys or upon any public or private property, or place any dodgers, bills or other advertising matter upon any telegraph, electric light or telephone pole within the limits of said borough.

# § 65-3. Displaying obscene or indecent material.<sup>2</sup>

It shall be unlawful for any person to place or post in any place of public resort or open to public use, or place in any window, door or other place open to public view or on any fence, wall or other place within said borough within view of or liable to be seen by persons passing or coming near the same, any obscene, indecent or immoral picture, poster, showbill, drawing, writing or printing of any kind.

## § 65-4. Violations and penalties.<sup>3</sup>

Any person or persons who shall violate any provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.) and costs of such proceedings or, in default of payment of such fine and costs, be subject to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.
