Member Safety

You are the members and owners of this water system. We all want safe dependable water for consumption. However from time to time we encounter leaks in the system, especially in periods of drought. If you have lost water pressure due to a leak or the water is cloudy and you are concerned about the water quality take the following simple precautions:

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to consumption. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling you may purchase bottled water from other suitable source. Also notify Tyler Ortmann at 830-391-0615 or Jim McWilliams at 830-251-8778 as to leaks, pressure loss or cloudy conditions of the water. MEMBERS NEED TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION. (E-Mail) So you can be notified in case of Emergencies.

Also if you provide water to cattle it is a state law that you provide an air break between the source of a public water supply and a storage water trough. Pressure loss can create suction on the system and submersible water floats could siphon stored water into the system. Be safe and replace any submersible or water level floats with water Floats that are above the water level in your water trough.

DO NOT INTER CONNECT 3 OAKS WATER SYSTEM LINE TO personal water supply. CROSS CONNECTIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
